University Women's Club book sale collects big \$8,000 for scholarships

Next year's sale
to include CDs,
videos, audio tapes

Bookworms flocked to the recent book sale held by the Canadian Federation of University Women (CFUW) — Milton district — and nothing demonstrates the enthusiasm clearer than the money raised.

The sale, held March 28 and 29 at Milton Mall, raised more than \$8,000, which is an increase of 60 per cent over funds raised last year, without an increase in book prices.

According to the CFUW, the event's success is due to the generosity of book donors as well as the hard work of 30 CFUW members.

This was the 30th annual book sale held by the CFUW.

Proceeds will be used to fund university scholarships for graduates of Milton high schools.

In addition to this, a significant donation of books was made to the Vanier Institute for Women, which recently relocated to Milton.

Next year, the sale will expand to include more than just books, with CDs, videos and audio tapes also being made available.

The CFUW is a national non-profit organization that's committed to the pursuit of knowledge, the promotion of education, improvement of the status of women and human rights, and active participation in public affairs.
