## Terry Fox Run is at risk of being cancelled

Needs volunteer organizers

After 22 years of fundraising for cancer research, the Milton Terry Fox Run is at risk of cancellation if volunteers don't come forward to help.

Long-time organizers Kim and Craig Thomas can't continue in their roles and have asked the Terry Fox Foundation for help in finding a replacement.

"Milton is such a caring community," said Martha McClew, Ontario provincial director. "Over \$360,000 has been raised in the

community since the inception of the Terry Fox Run and every dollar has made a difference in the battle to defeat cancer. We need communities like Milton to stay committed to this cause."

The foundation is seeking an energetic and enthusiastic individual who would be interested in leading a committee of volunteers in the organization of the Milton Terry Fox Run, which is scheduled for September 14.

The volunteer position requires

strong leadership skills, the ability to delegate, and someone who likes to work with a team of volunteers.

The organizer's responsibilities will include recruiting new members to the committee, facilitating monthly planning meetings, ensuring a safe route for the run, distribpromotional materials throughout the community and overseeing donations of food/beverages and other items.

The time commitment can be anywhere from two to four hours each week in the months leading up to the run.

Terry Fox's legacy now totals more than \$300 million and has contributed to many advances made in cancer research.


