Patrons can ask for restaurant inspection reports in Halton

If you're planning on eating out in Halton, you can now dine more wisely.

Since the first week of May, participating Halton restaurants have voluntarily been making available information about their food handling

practices through Dinewise, part of the Halton Region's health department's food safety program.

Information about an establishment's food handling practices is available at participating

restaurants, which post a certificate of inspection and have a summary inspection report available for the public to view upon request.

A summary inspection report outlines whether a restaurant has met basic food safety standards

as required by provincial legislation.
