ing her name in a book titled Great Gardens, by Patricia Singer.

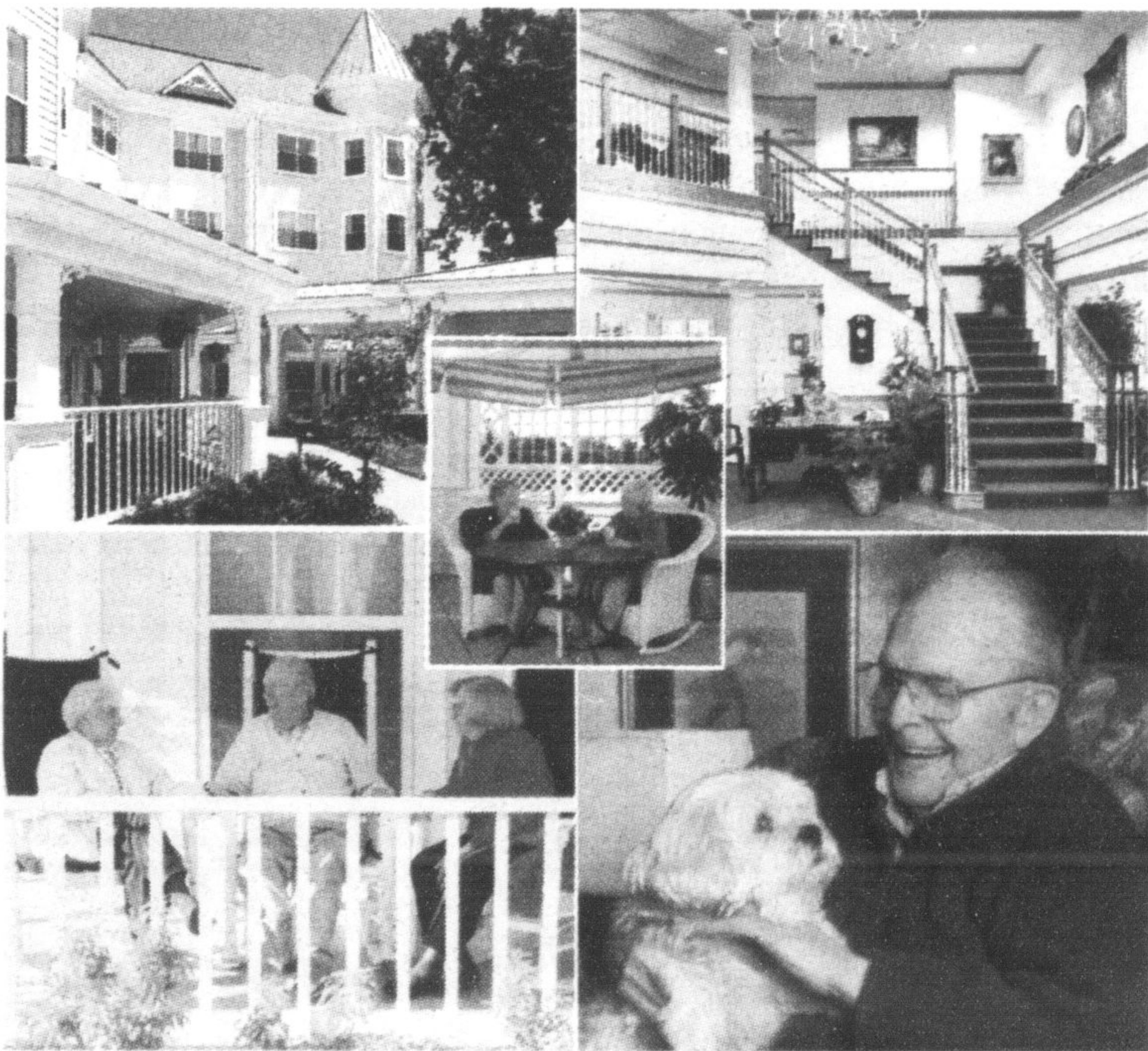

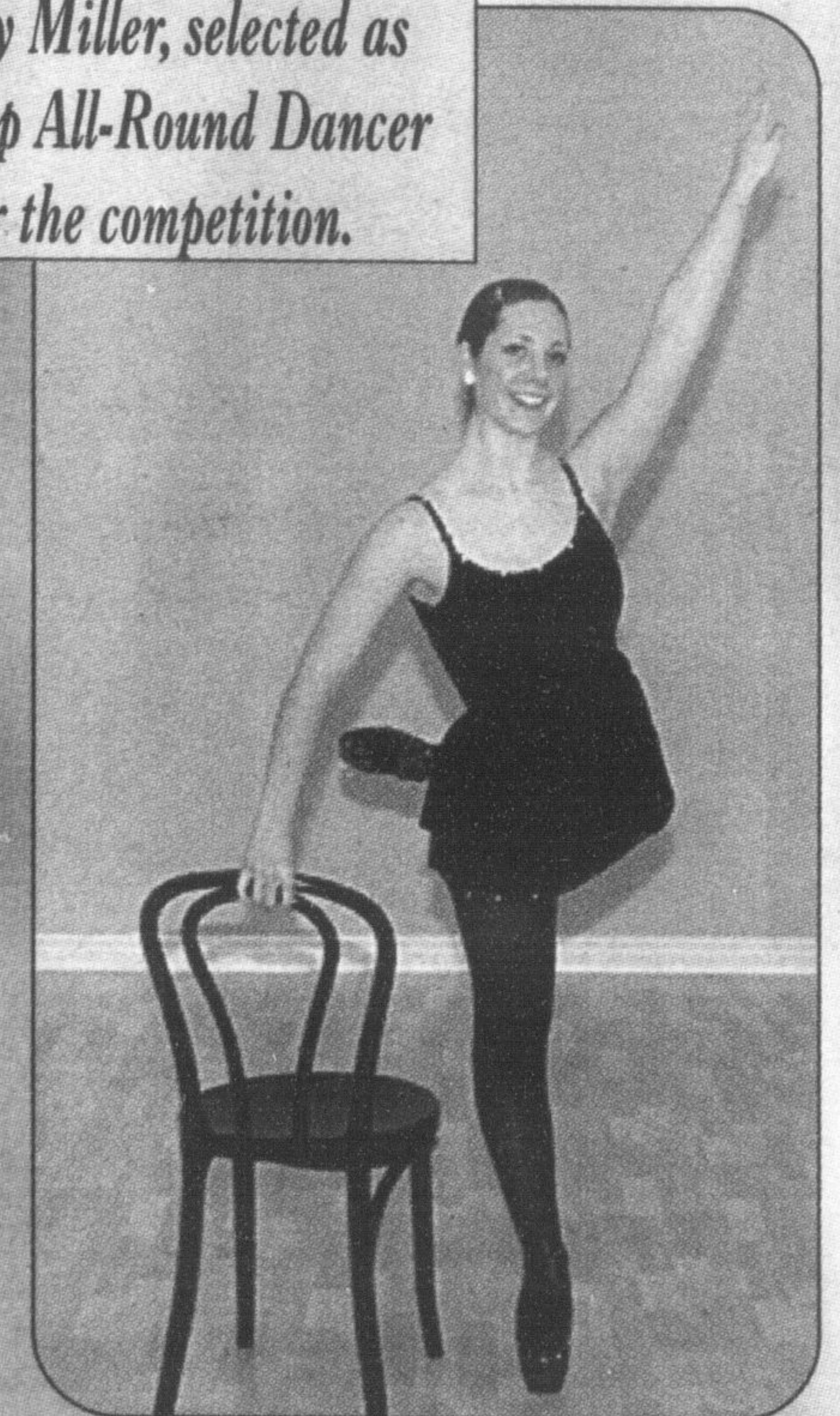

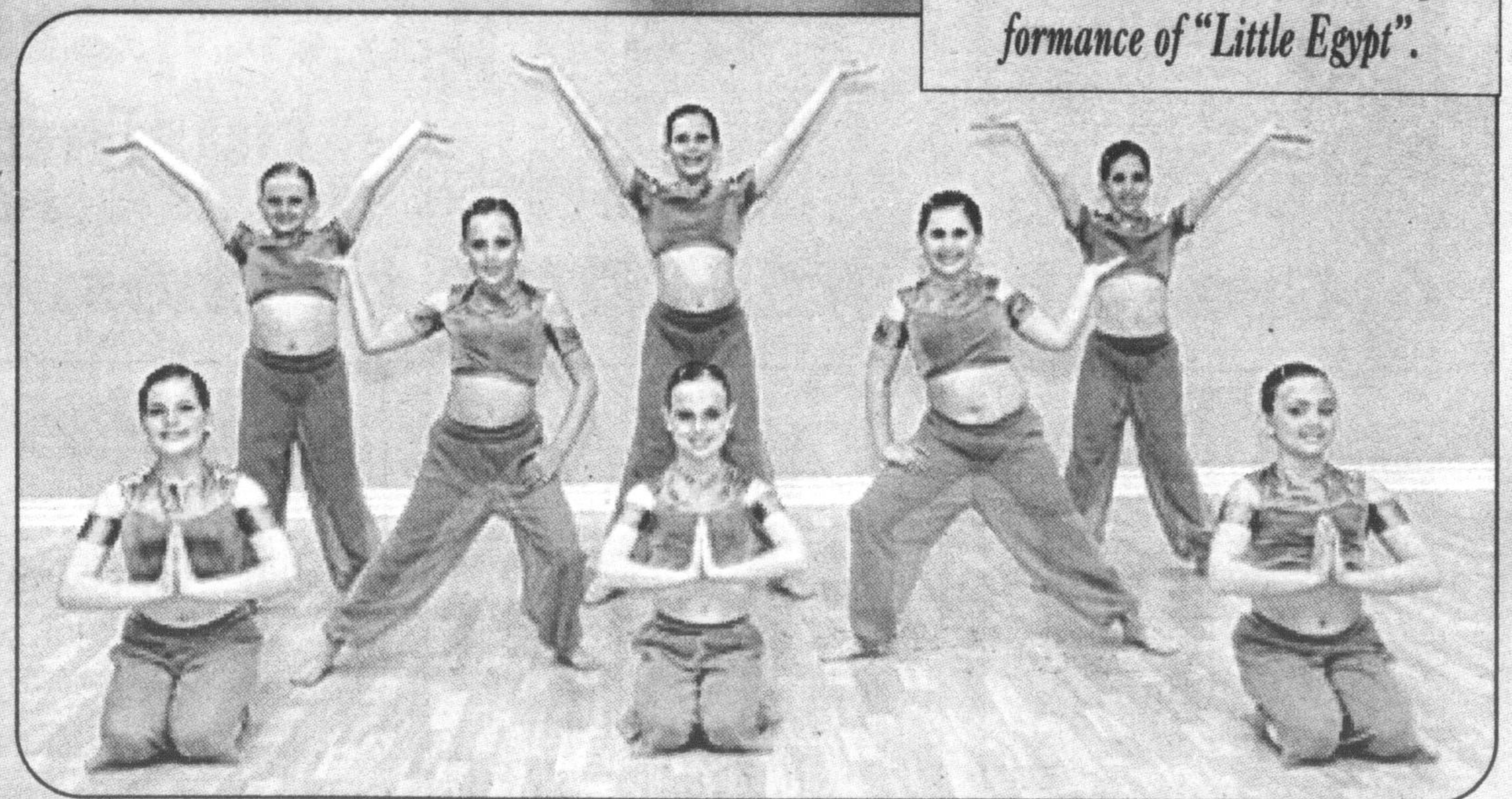
Carly Miller, selected as the Top All-Round Dancer for the competition.
