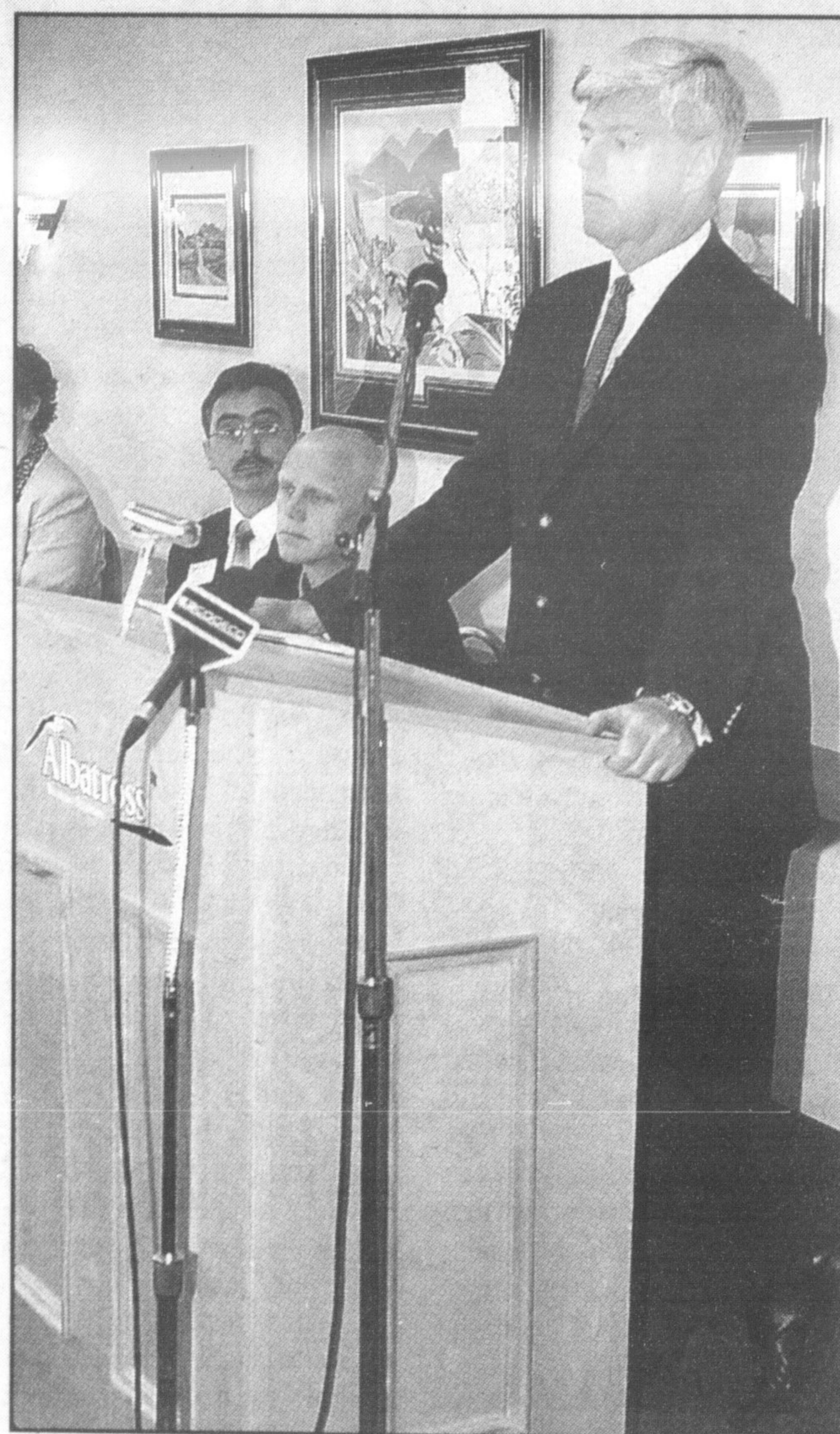




## Manley visits Milton

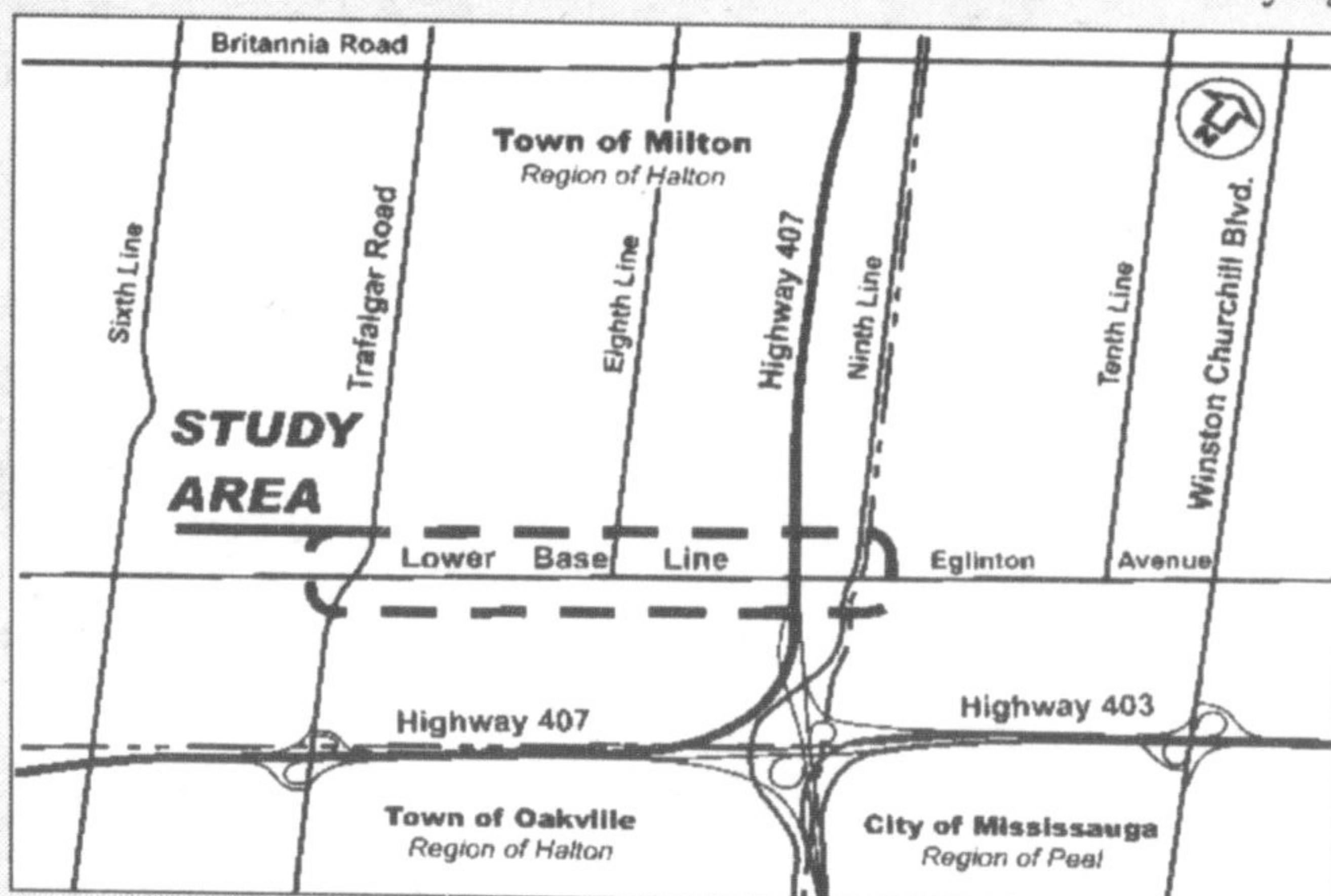

#### CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2

Lower Base Line Road between Trafalgar Road and Ninth Line is a 2 lane rural road with a bridge over Highway 407. In order to address the existing condition of Lower Base Line, the Town of Milton is carrying out a study of Lower Base Line (from Trafalgar Road to Ninth Line) in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process. The Town has retained the firm McCormick Rankin Corporation to complete the study.

Taking into consideration the comments received at the May 1, 2003 Public Information Centre #1, the Steering Committee has confirmed Alternative C as being the preferred alternative for the 2-lane reconstruction of Lower Base Line Road.

The second public information centre to review the preliminary plan for Alternative C and the preliminary landscaping plan has been arranged for:

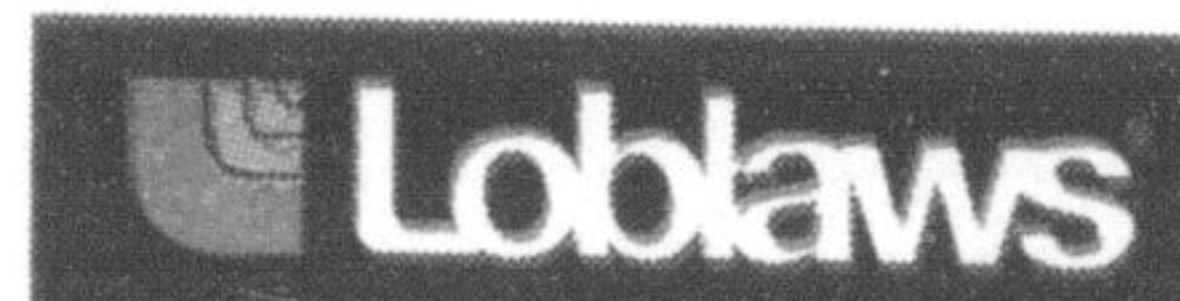
