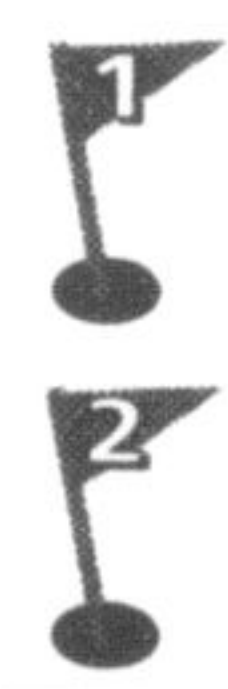

Two more election candidates register

Best looks to return to council

Two more people have registered to run in the fall municipal election.

Colin Best of Main Street West, a former Milton councillor from 1980 to 1994 and mayoral candidate in 1997, will seek one of two councillor positions in Ward 2.

Jennifer Mirosofin of Heslop Road has also signed up to run in the ward.

Wally Hunter and Art Melanson are the current Ward 2 councillors.

That brings the total number of people who've registered their intentions to run in the November municipal election to four.

No current town council members have filed so far to seek re-election.

Here's the process to sign up as a councillor, mayor, regional chair or school trustee.

Before deciding to run, there are some basic requirements that have to be met including being a Canadian citizen, at least 18 years of age and not having been disqualified by any legislation from holding municipal office.

In the case of school board trustee candidates, one must be a resident in the jurisdiction of the board.

Those interested must go to Town Hall at 43 Brown St. to fill out nomination papers. After signing the nomination papers, candidates are required to sign two affidavits.

One is to show proof of legal Canadian citizenship and residency of Milton. The other is to verify understanding of the role and requirements of a municipal politician or school board trustee.

The nomination papers and affidavits must be signed in front of and personally handed to the clerk or law clerk. At that point, candidates must swear an oath that all of the information submitted is true.

The fee to run for mayor or regional chair is \$200.

Running for councillor or school board trustee positions costs \$100. The term of office for municipal politicians and school board trustees is three years.

The closing date for nominations is September 26 at 5 p.m.
