As motorcyclists across Ontario gear up for the 2003 Ride for Sight in Collingwood, Milton will soon hold its very own kick off party.

The party will take place June 6 at the Hardball Cafe on Regional Road 25 from 9 p.m. to 2 a.m. There to entertain participants will be Joe Cahill from 97.7 HTZ FM.

This year marks the 25th anniversary of Ride for Sight, the largest motorcycle parade in Canada. It began in 1979 with the same goal it holds today — to raise money to help fight blindness. So far, motorcyclists and friends have raised more than \$11 million in pledges for the Foundation Fighting Blindness, Canada.

The Ride for Sight will take place from June 20 to 22 at the Great Northern Exhibition Fairgrounds in Collingwood. Participants can arrive on the Friday and enjoy a weekend of festivities, or ride up in the parade on the Saturday, which departs at 10 a.m. from the International Centre in Mississauga.

Weekend festivities will include bike games, bands, demonstration rides, a barbecue, karaoke and live and silent auctions. Even those who don't ride are invited to participate in the event.

Scott Seren, the Milton Ride for Sight co-ordinator, said the number of Milton participants is steadily increasing. Mr. Seren will have a Ride for Sight information booth at Milton Mall Friday from 6 to 9 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. He'll have pledge forms and said he'll be happy to answer any questions from those interested in participating.
