## PRIORITIES PAVE THE PATHWAY TO SUCCESS

In the greatest discourse ever given on the essentials of lasting happiness, Jesus Christ urged His followers to "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness." We've cleaned up the air, but polluted the soul.*

*We have higher incomes, but lower morals;  
More food but less appeasement;  
We have more acquaintances, but fewer friends;  
We expend more effort, but have less success.  
These are days of two incomes, but more divorce;*

*Of fancier houses, but broken homes;  
Of tall men and short character;  
Of steep profits, and shallow relationships.*

How can this alarming trend be reversed? By prioritizing a relationship with God. Proverbs, the Old Testament book of wisdom, declares that if we "Put God first in everything we do, He will crown our efforts with success." What a promise!
