In the greatest discourse ever given on the essentials of lasting happiness, Jesus Christ urged His followers to "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness." Of steep profits, and shallow relationships.

How can this alarming trend be reversed? By prioritizing a relationship with God. Proverbs, the Old Testament book of wisdom, declares that if we "Put God first in everything we do, He will crown our efforts with success." What a promise!


