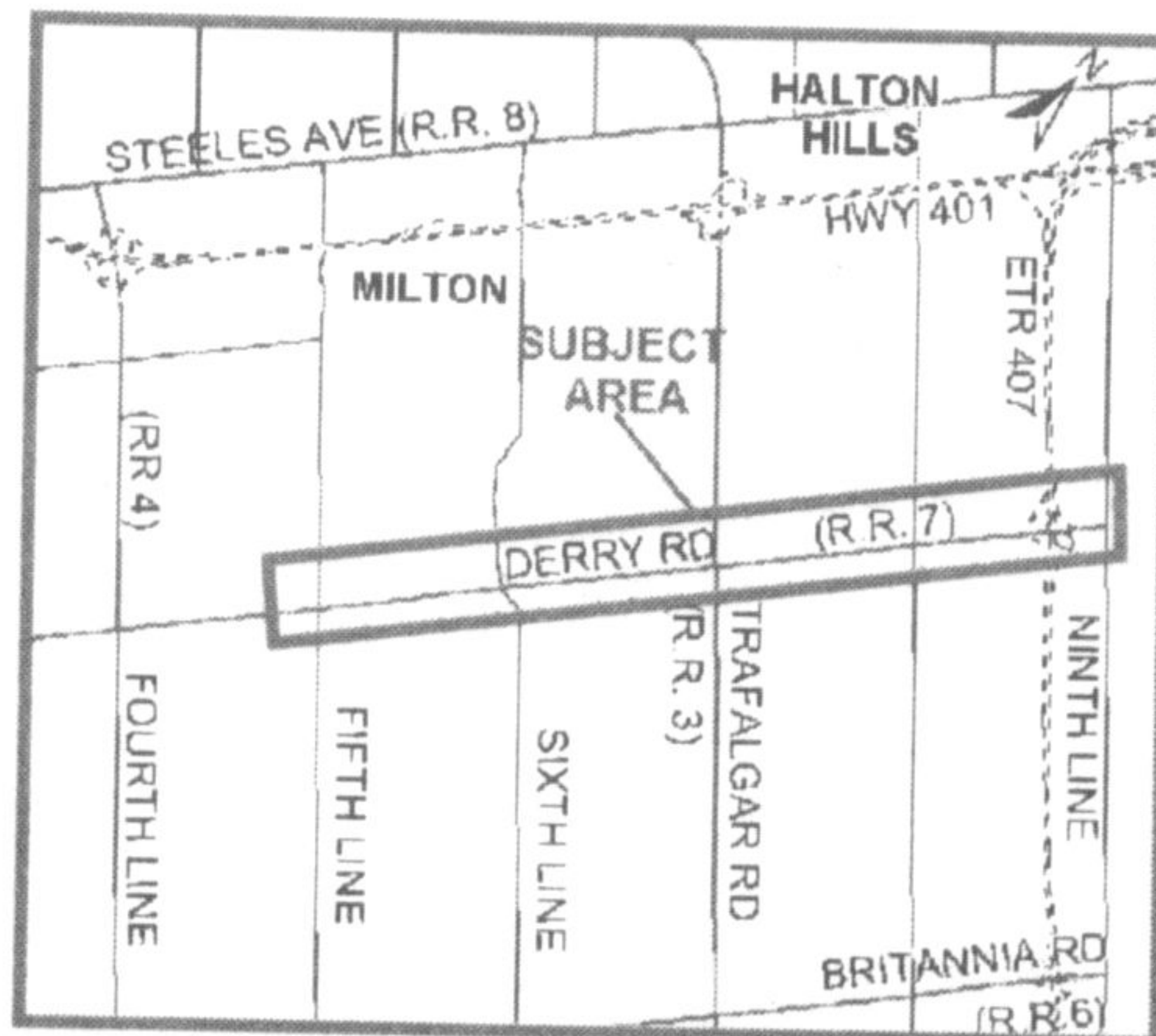

NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Derry Road (Regional Road 7) Improvements Class Environmental Assessment Study, Town of Milton

The Regional Municipality of Halton has undertaken a Class Environmental Assessment to consider options to satisfy travel demand on Derry Road, from Fifth Line to Ninth Line (see map of the study area). A number of planning and design alternatives were considered. Based on input provided from stakeholders, technical agencies and public participants, as well as on an assessment by the study team, the Region has determined that the preferred solution is widening of Derry Road from two lanes to four lanes, including improvements to the existing horizontal alignment.



The study was conducted in compliance with Schedule 'C' of the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (June 2000)*. In accordance with the *Municipal Class EA*, an Environmental Study Report (ESR) was prepared to document the planning and decision-making processes followed.

By this notice, the ESR is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the *Municipal Class EA*. Subject to comments received as a result of this notice, the Region intends to proceed with detailed design and construction of the section of Derry Road from Fifth Line to Ninth Line.

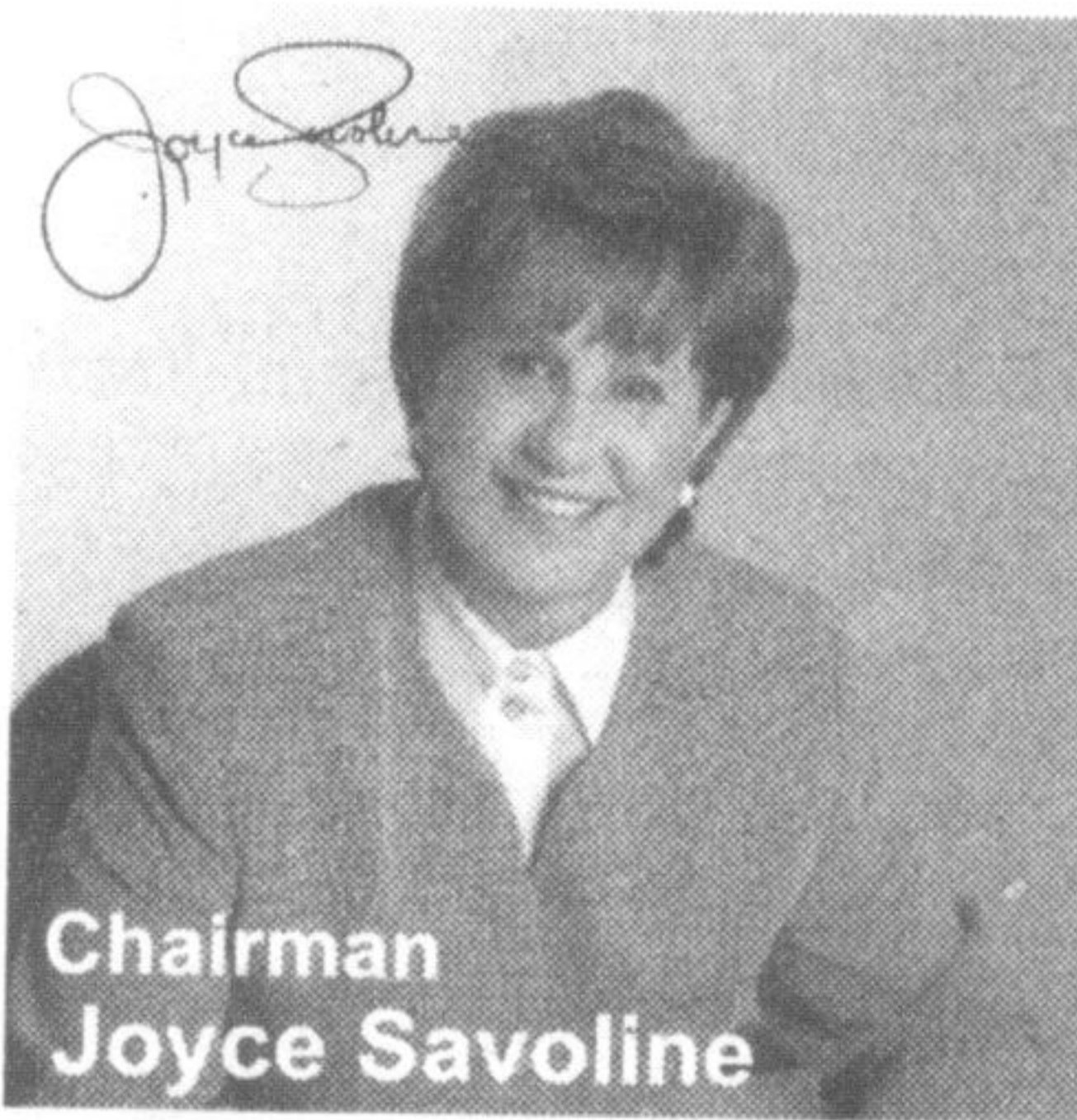

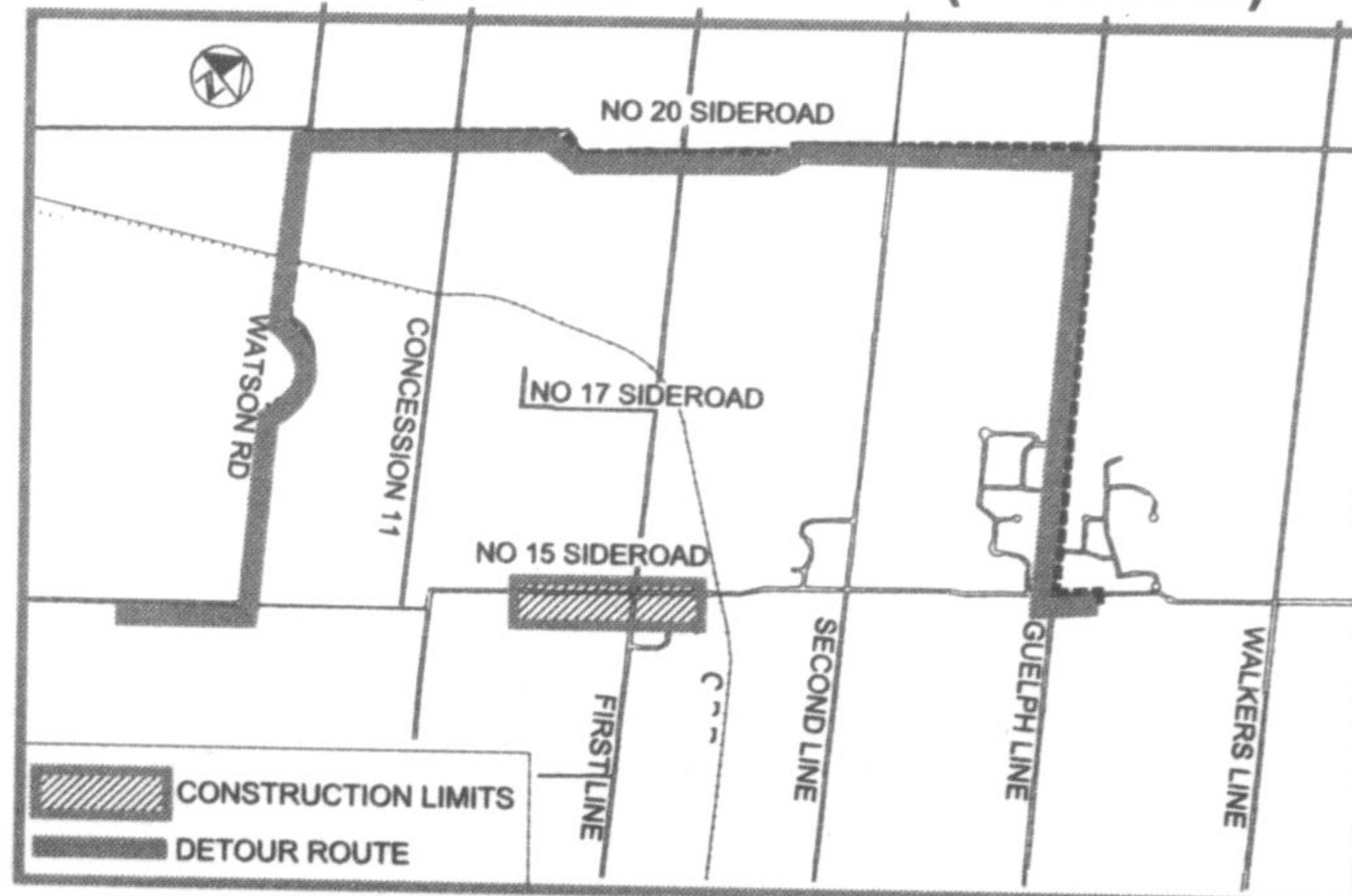

KNOLL REMOVAL ON 15 SIDEROAD (REGIONAL ROAD 15) at FIRST LINE (MOFFAT)



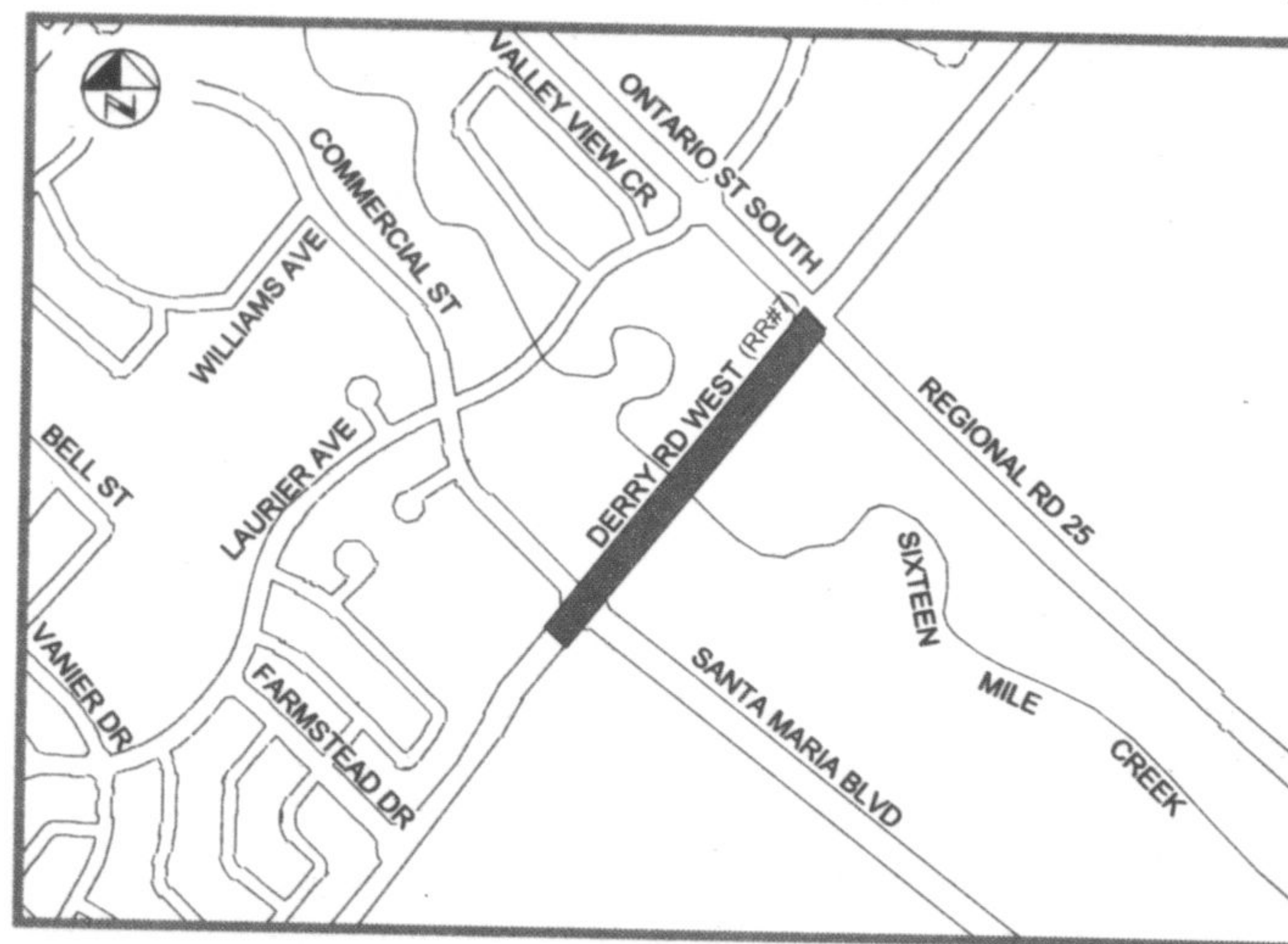
