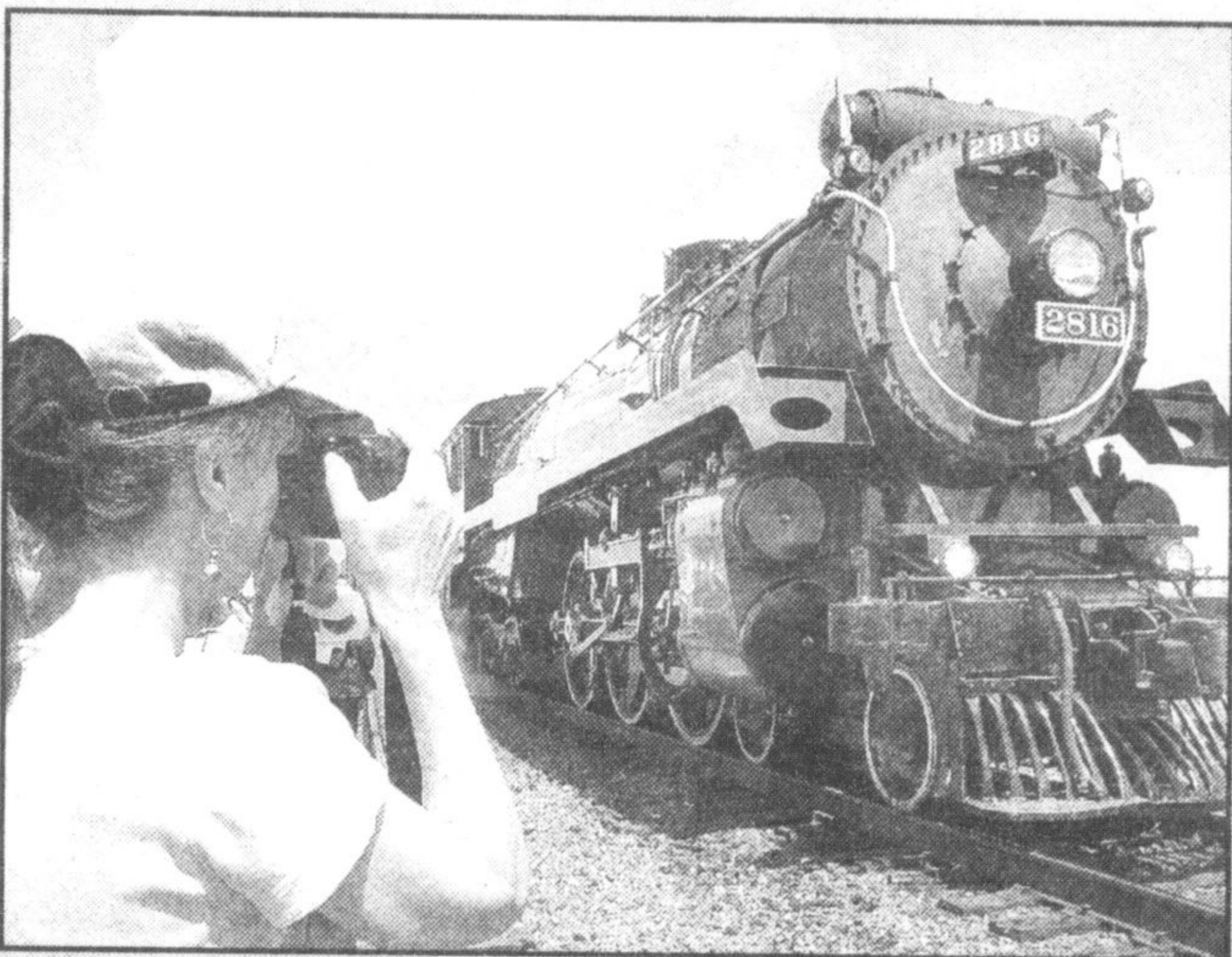




Steamin' into town

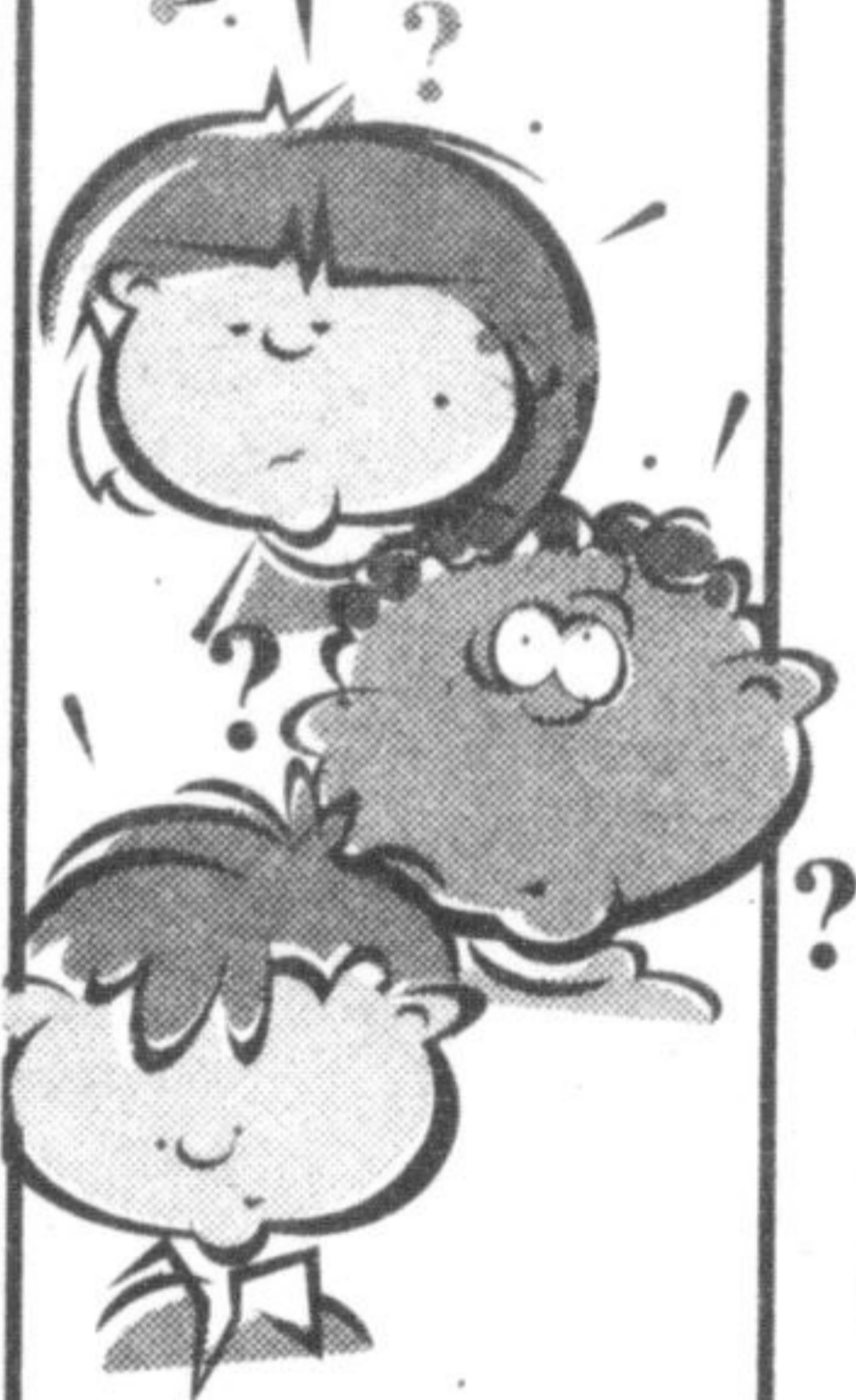
The restored CPR Empress locomotive 2816 steamed into town Saturday afternoon to a waiting throng of more than 1,000 spectators, who lined the rails for its arrival. The Empress — a class H1b Hudson locomotive built in Montreal in 1930 — is the only remaining Hudson class locomotive in North America.
