Thank You For Calling Halton Healthcare

Callers to Milton District Hospital's main number - 905-878-2383 - are now able to directly access any extension in the Hospital.

The new electronic switchboard will provide callers with a number of selection choices. Incoming telephone calls will be immediately answered by an automated attendant that will provide each caller with access to a number of options including hospital extensions, patient locating, frequently called numbers, and a staff directory that can be searched by employee or department name.

Those requiring operator assistance or those calling from a rotary phone will be directed to dial "0" which will connect them with an operator who will be able to assist them further.

The implementation of the automated attendant follows the success of the same system at other hospitals.


