



Well..... the process works. Last year you, the OEB's proposed policy can be found at: members, brought the Hydro Security Deposit issue to our http://www.oeb.gov.on.ca/html/en/industryrelations/ attention. The Milton Chamber immediately agreed that ongoingprojects securitydeposits.htm. demanding a permanent security deposit of Milton's large hydro consumers (>50 kW), was poor business practice and harmful to our productiveness and competitiveness. We also believed that Milton's large consumers were just the starting point. This policy would eventually be expanded to include businesses throughout the province, as well as smaller business and residential consumers. On your behalf, we tried to negotiate better terms through Milton Hydro, the Town of Milton, the Ontario Chamber of Commerce, the provincial government, and finally the Ontario Energy Board. Upon hearing the issue, the OEB set up a working group, and invited the Milton Chamber to participate. Dawn Case and Rob Clarke attended numerous meetings on behalf of our members, sitting on both the working group and sub-committee. I'd like to thank them both for their participation. Without their strong vocal opposition to the LDC position, I doubt there would be any recognition of good payment history.

Today, I'm proud to report to you that it looks like all of our efforts are going to pay off. The Ontario Energy Board has put forward a proposed security policy that covers all users, as we expected. Thanks to Dawn and Rob, it reflects our guiding us through the various channels, and keeping the position, i.e. those businesses with good payment history Board informed. Thank you to Dawn Case and Rob Clarke (GPH) will be recognized as such, and will not be subjected for attending the working group and sub-committee to a security deposit to be held indefinitely. There are still meetings and giving the Milton Chamber a strong voice on some details to be worked out, and the policy still has to be behalf of business. The OEB is inviting public comment on their proposed policy until July 10th. I urge you to participate in the process, and make your position known to the OEB. As you can see, it does work. One of the areas still up in the air involves the method for calculating the security deposit for non-residential <50 kW consumers - using customer specific average consumption or using a class or sub-class average consumption. The Chamber will be responding in favour of the customer specific average consumption method.

What does this mean? Those businesses that paid the security deposit last year, and who have 7 years of GPH. will be able to request a full refund of their deposits once the new policy goes into effect.

The Milton Chamber has provided very real, tangible value to those businesses, as well as all of Milton's businesses, and that is the Chamber's job. It wouldn't be possible to do that job though, without some very strong employees and volunteers, and I'm proud and grateful to be associated with all of you. Thank you to Sandy Martin for


