
Buck has undergone a sponsorship

## Charity golf tourney runs July 25

Started last year, the charity event — held in memory of the hearing-impaired New Jersey Devils prospect who died of pneumonia in 2001 — was an overwhelming success, allowing Team Canada to travel to Sweden in March and defend its gold medal.

Among the members of the two-time championship squad was Miltonian Mark Couture, an assistant captain who helped anchor the blueline.

The Canadians will be gunning for a coveted threepeat in 2007 in Utah, but will need the continued success of such events as the local golf tournament for that to be possible.

A \$130 entry fee includes the cost of dinner and golfing, while individual and corporate donations are also welcome.


