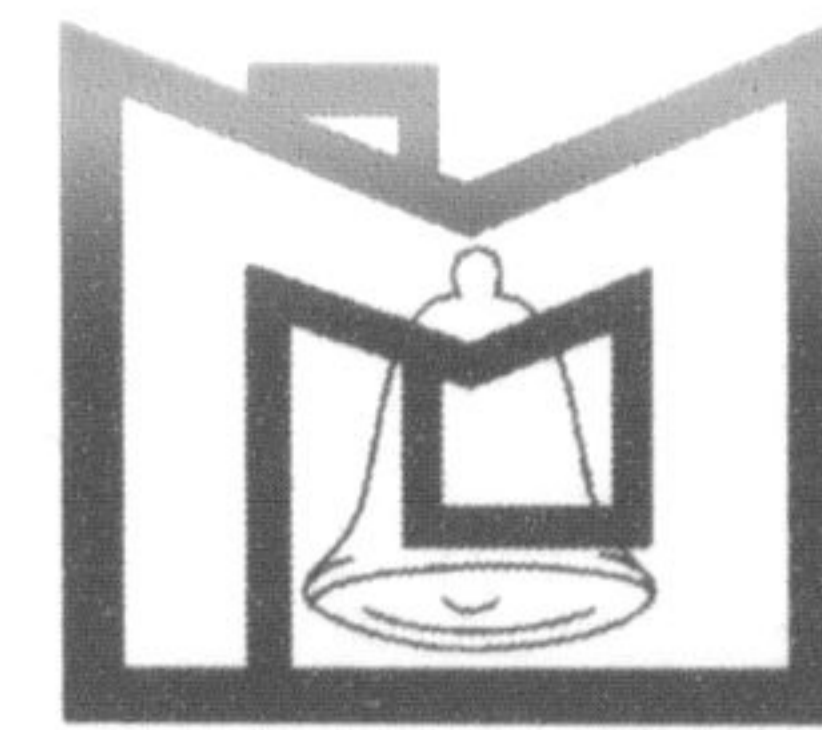
If you can relate to Candace Bushnell, or just wish you could, her latest opus is 'Trading Up', which tells the story of a lingerie model. In a
