We have been in the industry for over 15 years between the three of us and have had many accolades in print such as a single page write up in the September 14, 2002 edition of the Toronto Star for our setting of a Canadian SPL (Sound Pressure Level) record. We have also been in the July edition of Popular Science for the setting of a world SPL record, and many write ups in the Canadian magazine Performance Auto and Sound.

To us customer satisfaction is our number one goal. We have industry leading products, and industry leading warranties. The average warranty on audio equipment is one year. Perfect Tones' average warranty period is three years on the equipment, and we also offer lifetime warranty on our wiring because we solder all of our connections, which is not common practice in this industry. We also use industry leading computer programs to assist us in the installation of remote starters and alarm systems. These programs remove the element of chance and the guess work when working on your vehicle's electrical system.

We also use tools that you will not find in the average shop. We have scanning systems that will diagnose problems and read error codes for vehicle security systems and remote starters so we can properly diagnose any problems that may arise.

**Competing with Perfect Tones** 

This industry is more than just who can make the most noise, there are competitions and sanctioning bodies throughout the world that judge on sound quality and level of difficulty of the installation. This is called I.A.S.C.A. or International Auto Sound Challenge Association. There are awards for best install, best sounding system, and best parts fabrication. This is considered the Golf of this type of sport.

Then there is noise making competition, or the boxing of car stereo sports. This organization is called DB Drag racing. This is probably the most renowned and widely known association. The goal of this sport is to produce the most sound pressure inside of the vehicles cabin with only audio equipment such as subwoofers and amplifiers. For example, a 747 Jumbo jet at take off can produce 135 decibles of sound. On average the typical aftermarket car stereo will produce in excess of 140 decibles. Now at the top of this scale a space shuttle launching pad will produce approximately 180 decibles. The current world record is 177.7 decibles, which is held by Team BS from Germany.

Perfect Tones has done a competition vehicle for the last two years. The first, Disco Stu, it was named, had two Beyond Audio 15 inch subwoofers and 8 amplifiers. The Vehicle was an 88 Isuzu Imark Turbo, which was full of 1.5 inch MDF and 8 golf cart batteries. The car won pretty well every show it went to, and ended up placing 3rd in the world at IASCA last summer. This year we decided to go all out. We bought a 86 Nissan Multi due to its small cabin space yet

large rear area. We proceeded to cut the roof out and pour 50 bags of concrete in the interior. Using 2 Treo Engineering 18 inch subwoofers, 20 deep cycle batteries, 8 4000 watt amplifiers, we set the world record for SPL in our class at Audio Thunder 2003. Our future goals for this vehicles is to compete at the DB Drag racing world finals in October and hopefully

Safety is one of the number one concerns for the DB Drag racing association owner Wayne Harris. The competitors are not allowed to be inside of the vehicle during the system testing. If the system will produce less then 140 decibles the contestant must wear aviator





