

Boost your wine cellar with the Wine Connection

There's no better time than the present to give a boost to your wine cellar.

Fine wines from award-winning boutique wineries delivered to your door is the concept behind The Canadian Champion Wine Connection — a wine ordering program featuring bottles for sale that aren't readily available at LCBO outlets.

All of the wines offered have been selected by wine critics from The Toronto Star and Hamilton Spectator.

"Selecting wines for the Wine Connection has been truly rewarding," said Dan Kislenko, wine critic for the Spectator. "It is a unique service which allows me to connect with readers. The overwhelmingly positive response to

the program is gratifying."

Beginning at 8 a.m. today (Friday) and until August 14, Champion readers can phone the Canadian Champion Wine Connection hotline or visit the Web site to learn all about the program and order wine.

The program offers ordering options that range in price from about \$60 to about \$80 for six bottles.

There's a small delivery charged added to the total. Customers can purchase packages that contain white wines, red wines and a mix of the two varieties.

Gordon Stimmell, the Star's wine critic, says Wine Connection offers Champion readers a chance to sample great wines that aren't nor-

mally offered at LCBO outlets.

"The success of the Wine Connection program has provided me with great satisfaction in knowing that we have helped readers learn about and discover some remarkably good wines," he said.

Among the critic's picks that are available through Canadian Champion Wine Connection are Cave Spring Cellars 2000 Pinot Noir, Henry of Pelham 2001 Mosaic Gamay/Zweigelt, Angels Gate 2002 Vidal and Strewn 2002 Sauvignon Blanc.

As a special addition to Canadian Champion Wine Connection latest offering, organizers are offering customers a chance to participate in Cellar Essentials. The program gives those

interested in starting their own wine collections four excellent bottles to stock their cellars.

Cellar Essentials offered include Thomas and Vaughan 2000 Meritage, Kacaba 2000 Cabernet, Crown Bench Reserve 2000 Chardonnay and Stoney Ridge 2002 Sauvignon Blanc.

Those bottles are sold in a four-pack, retailing for about \$90.
