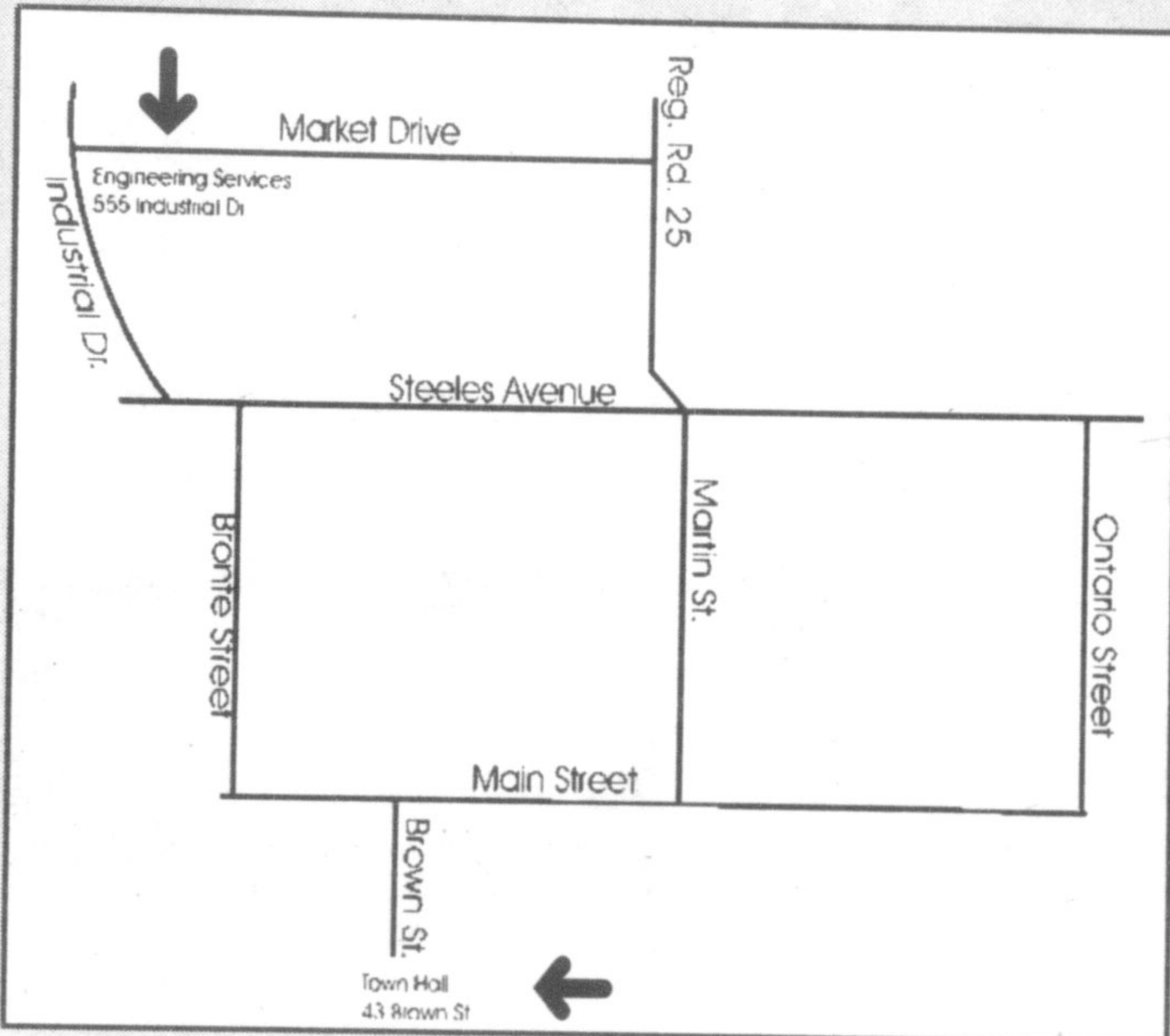

Inside was a great example of the human spirit. Sue Hanak and a friend were on lunch from work. Standing in line, they were awaiting their sandwich when 20-year-old Troy Vienert asked if he could jump ahead to ask for lemonade. The two easily obliged.

The gesture might have been small but on a day that was anything but ordinary, it was huge.

Enjoying her assorted sub, Ms Hanak said, "You have to be easy-going about it all. There's not much you can do about it."

Some entrepreneurs — in this case employees from Arctic Glacier, an ice-making company — recognized this was a good time for business, but made sure they didn't gouge people.

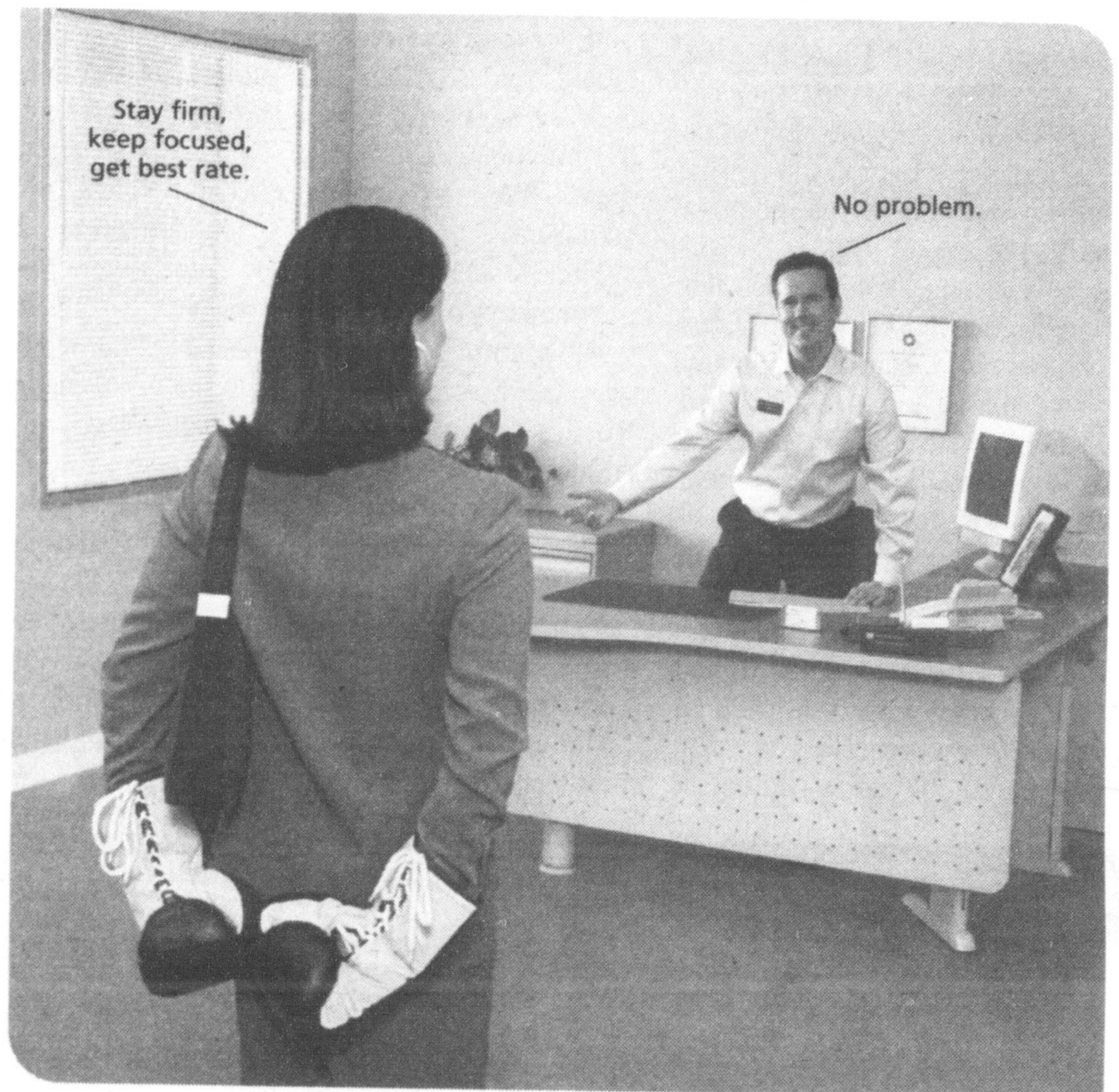
Out of the back of a truck located on the Milton Mall parking lot, they were selling bags of ice for \$2 each. Usually stores sell them for \$2.25, said Arctic Glacier employee Corey Bowen, a Milton resident.

"We don't want to be gouging people and wrecking our reputation," he said. "We've got to keep it honest."

By 3 p.m., they sold about 4,000 bags of ice.

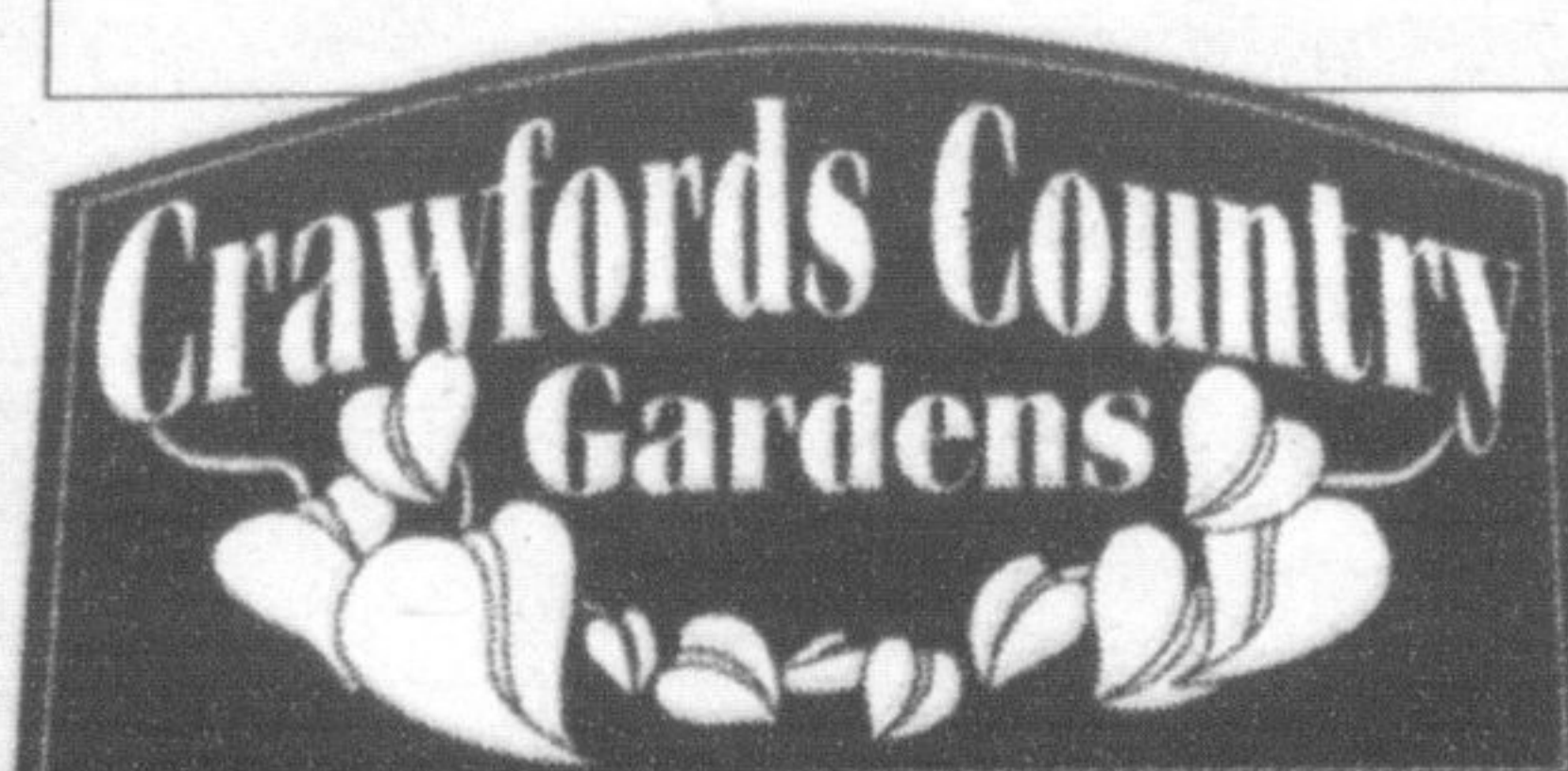

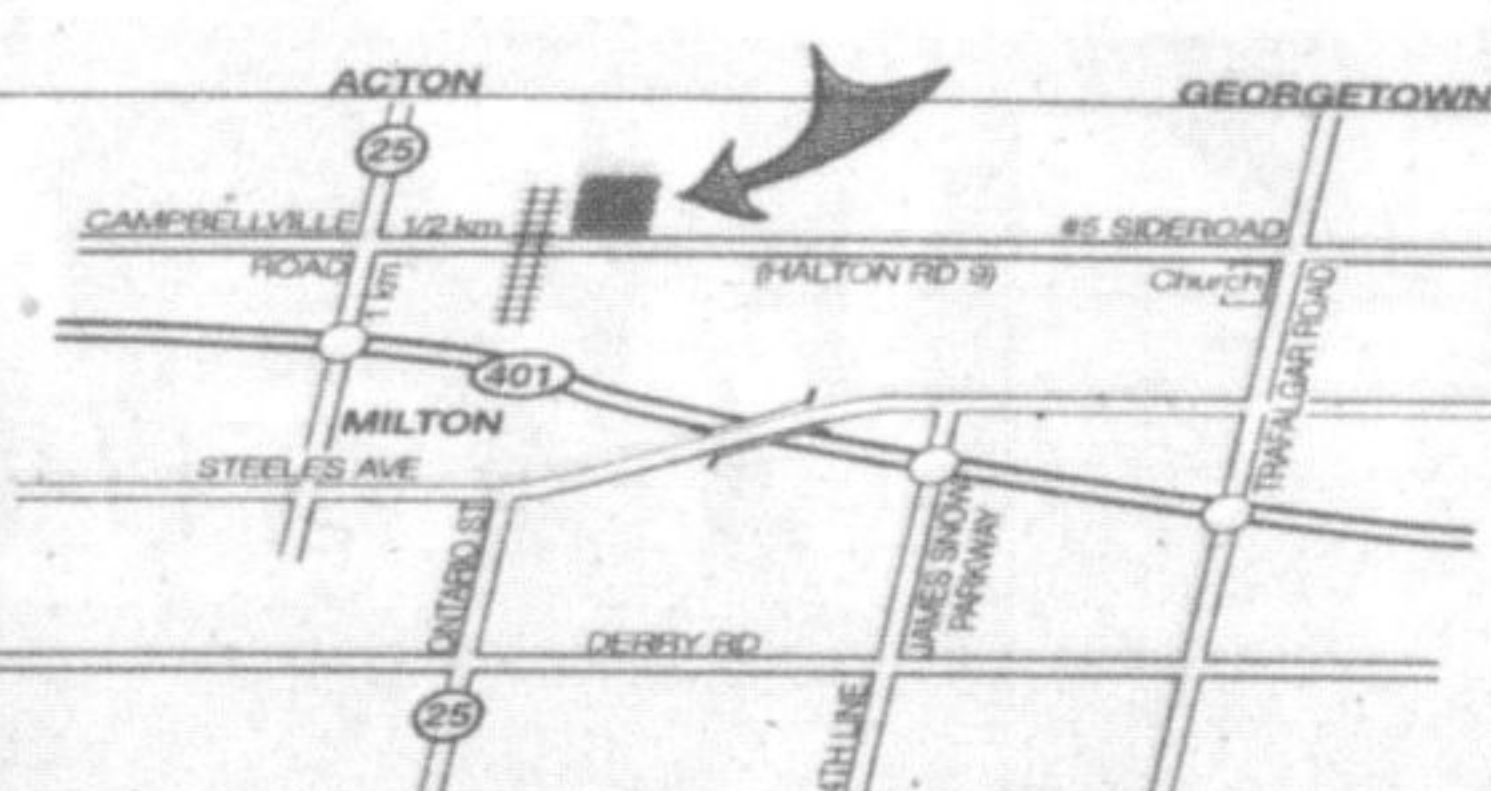

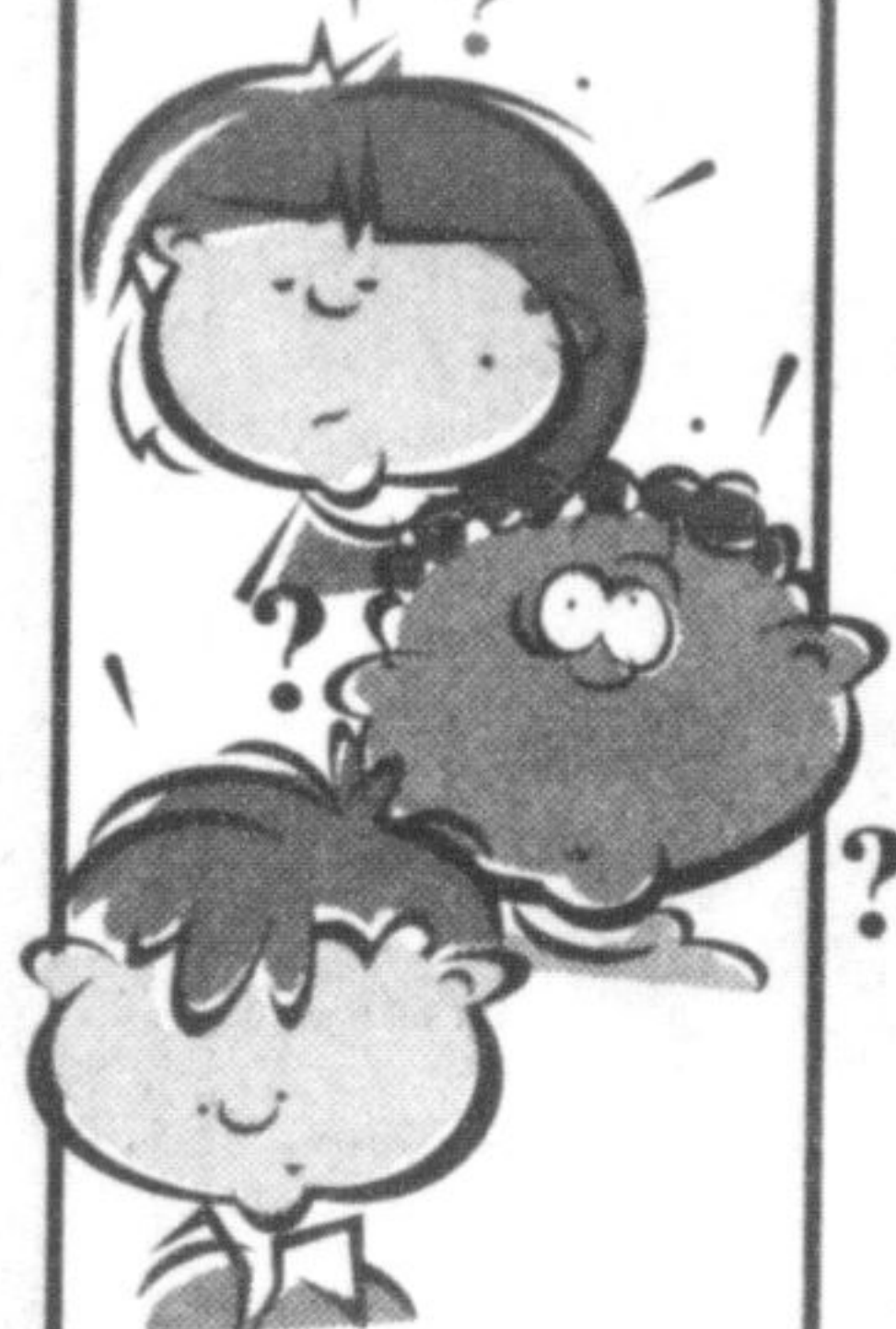
