The Milton-based North Halton Red Cross branch is looking for a branch council volunteer interested in fund development.

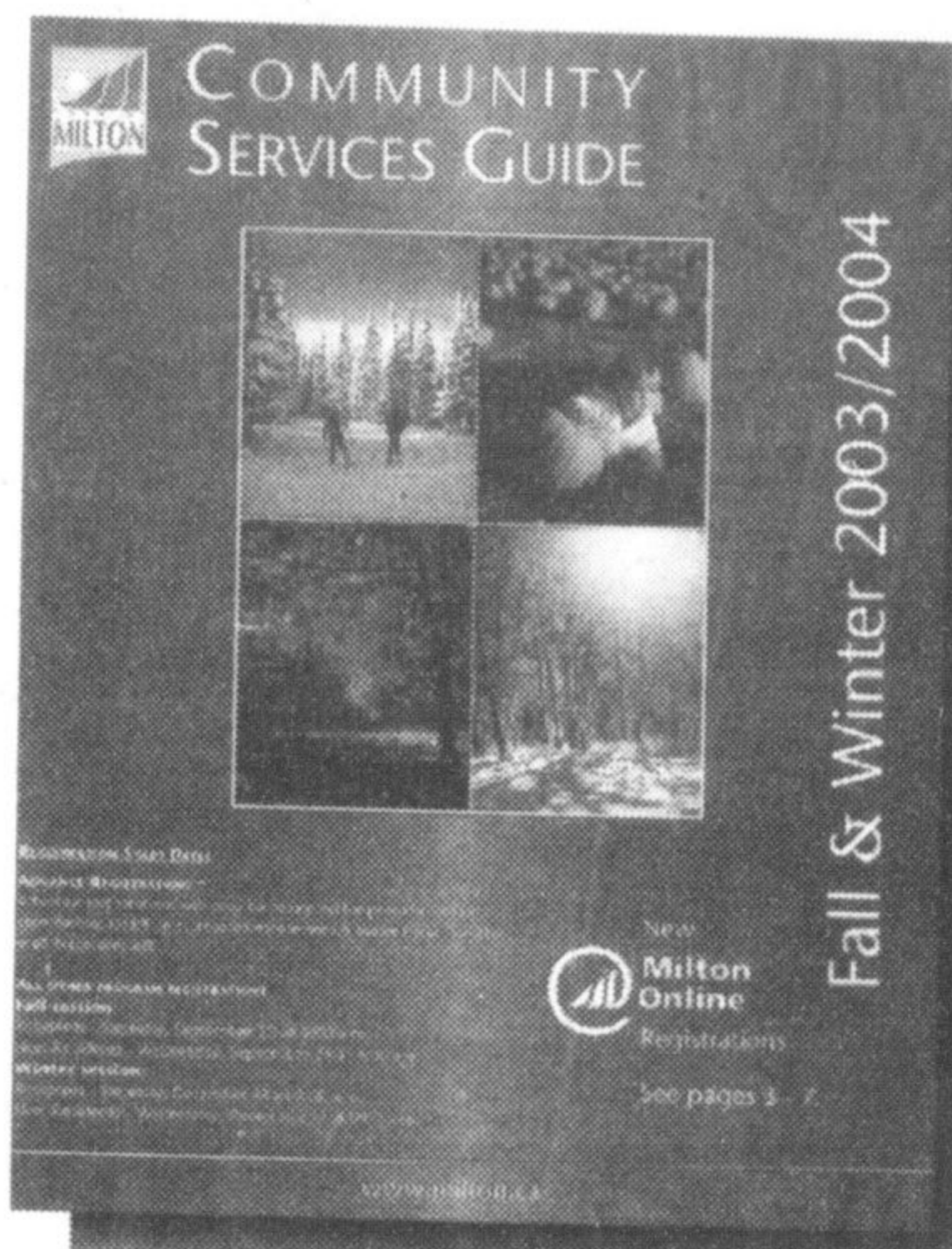
The interested individual would oversee and guide one of the following portfolios of the fund development committee of the branch: special events, corporate dona-

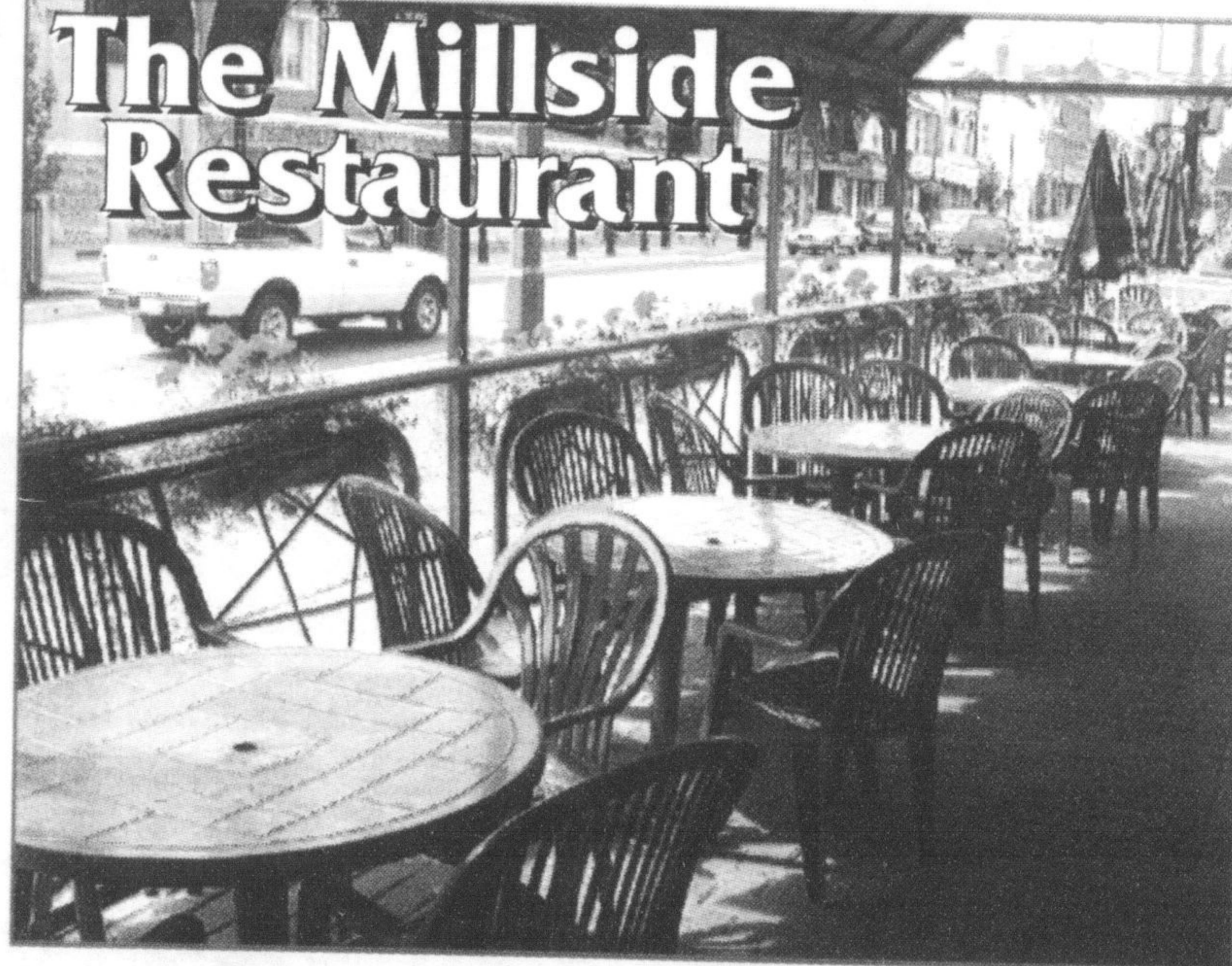
