NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING AN AMENDMENT TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE TOWN OF MILTON RELATING TO ROADS RECLASSIFICATION

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Town of Milton will hold a Public Meeting on:

Date: Monday, October 20, 2003
Time: 7:30 p.m.
Place: Council Chambers, Town Hall, 43 Brown Street, Milton

to receive information and public input on an amendment to the Town of Milton Official Plan, as amended, pursuant to Sections 17 and 21 of the *Planning Act*, as amended.

The purpose and effect of the Local Official Plan Amendment is to implement the completed and approved Halton Functional Road Network (2003), through revisions to the applicable Town of Milton Official Plan text and schedules affected by the above noted information.

Copies of coloured key maps illustrating the following: (1) the transfer of roads between the Region of Halton and the Town of Milton, and (2) the classification of roads within the Region of Halton, which are the basis for this amendment as it affects the Town of Milton, along with the proposed Local Official Plan Amendment addressing these changes will be available at the Planning & Development Department Counter (located on the upper floor of the Annex Building next to Town Hall) and on the Town of Milton homepage in the headline news section at www.milton.ca as of Wednesday, October 1, 2003. Further background information documents will only be available at the Planning & Development Department counter.

Written Submissions & Attendance At The Public Meeting

Any interested person may make a written submission, prior to the Public Meeting, and should direct the submission to the attention of Director of Planning and Development. Additional technical information is available from the Director of Engineering Services.

ANY PERSON MAY attend the Public Meeting to obtain information and make a verbal presentation and/or written submission, to identify issues of concern and/or express views in support of, or in opposition to, the proposed Official Plan Amendment. A copy of information Report PD-90-03, the proposed Official Plan Amendment and coloured schedules, (as noted above) and any other background information will be available on Wednesday, October 1, 2003. Copies of the documents may be reviewed or obtained by visiting the Planning and Development

Department, Town Hall, 43 Brown Street. The Planning & Development Department can also be contacted by dialing 905-878-7252 ext. 2398.

It is the intent of the Town of Milton to pass the adopting by-law on the same evening as the public meeting. A related staff report will also be presented to Council for their consideration. Copies of the staff report will be available in the Planning and Development Department (Annex Building next to Town Hall), 43 Brown Street and online on the Town of Milton website at www.milton.ca (under Council Agendas/Minutes which can be selected in the optional search feature box) on Friday, October 17, 2003 after 3:00 p.m.

Persons who sign the register at the Public Meeting, or who file a written request for notification with the Town of Milton Planning and Development Department, will be notified of the passing of the by-law.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED that if a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Milton in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Milton before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.
