Photos of war dead sought in project

One of the "men we never knew" was Edward Charles Hamman, killed in the First World War.

A farmer from the Campbellville area, he joined the 5th Battalion of the Canadian Overseas Expeditionary Force in September 1914. Within eight months he was killed in action near Ypres, Belgium.

A picture of him has been forwarded by family members during the current search for photos of those from Milton and Nassagaweya who are remembered on the

cenotaph in Victoria Park and at Haltonville. The Champion, Milton Historical Society and Royal Canadian Legion are co-operating in the search as part of a remembering project.

There are more than 60 names on the cenotaphs in Victoria Park, (Milton) and Haltonville (Nassagaweya). Details of their war careers has been compiled from official records but pictures would help re-introduce them to current and future generations.

Photos, which are loaned, will be scanned and the original returned unless the lender prefers that the original be kept by the historical society archives, Legion Hall of Remembrance or Halton Region Museum archives.

sion. They're taxpayers of the town," he said. "What does 'discouraged' mean? Make it clear or get rid of it."

Both Mayor Krantz and Deputy Chief Krantz agreed the policy needs to be revisited.

"We've (he and his wife) owned the house since the '80s and we both have worked as hard to pay for the house and why should her democratic rights be suppressed. I think it needs to be narrowed down," said Deputy Chief Krantz.

Town CAO Mario Belvedere said the Town has "never had to deal with these issues before," noting an e-mail was sent to Town employees Monday of last week alerting them of the policy.

Asked if the policy will be reviewed, he said: "I don't think we want to discuss these things in the heat of an election. I think these are issues better discussed, to sit down and to look at everything.

"(The policy) has worked in the way it's been intended."

But clarification of the policy is also critical, Mr. Malboeuf said, from an election point of view because the posting of signs can determine a successful campaign.

"Signs are very important. It's name recognition and it shows the amount of grassroots support out there," he said. "That's why a good portion of an election budget is based on election signs."

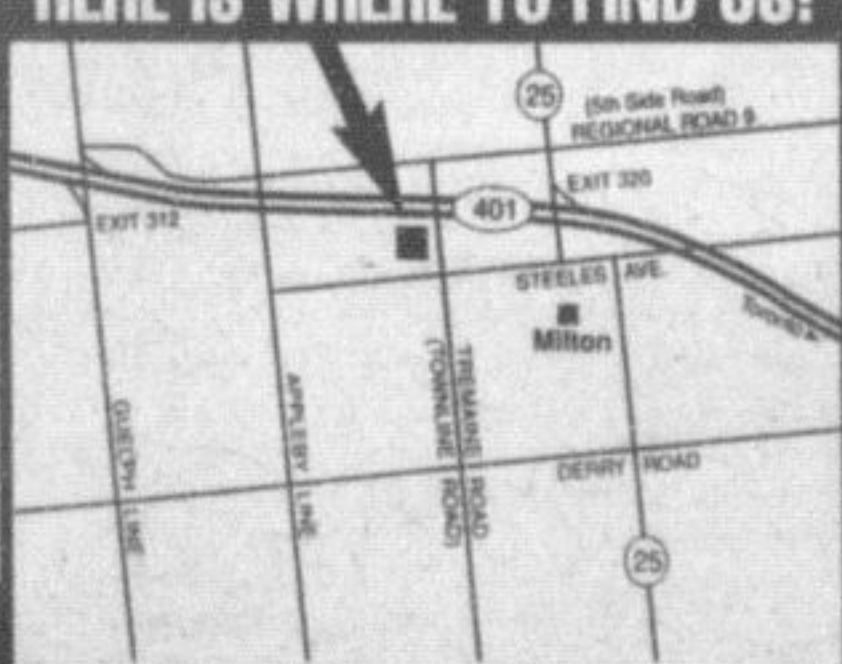
