## Region plans offers recommendations to improve youth services in Halton

In May Halton regional council endorsed a series of initiatives outlined in the Region's Youth Services Plan, entitled 'The Truth About Youth: Making Services Better for Youth'.

Recently council took the next step in supporting the work.

"Youth face many of the same issues as other sectors of the community, such as the need for housing, transportation and recre-

ation services, yet sometimes their needs are overlooked," said Adelina Urbanski, Halton's commissioner of social and community services.

Through the Truth About Youth plan, Halton youth, as well as individuals and agencies interested in youth, have come up with 27 concrete recommendations to foster greater awareness of the issues and realities facing youth and to enhance services for youth.

The Youth Services Plan was launched to the community in June of this year, when more than 100 individuals from various sectors, including youth, service providers, parents, educators, businesses, police, and others attended a forum to discuss how each could contribute to implementing the recommendations of the plan.

Recommendations included the need for a recognition of diversity, the need for multi-purpose youth centres, appropriate and accessible housing, support for parents and enhanced police-youth relations.

Working groups made up of community partners and volunteers have been established to address these various priorities, and have developed terms of reference as well as strategies and timelines for action.

At its October 8 meeting, regional council approved the allocation of \$60,000 to the working groups to assist with their work.


