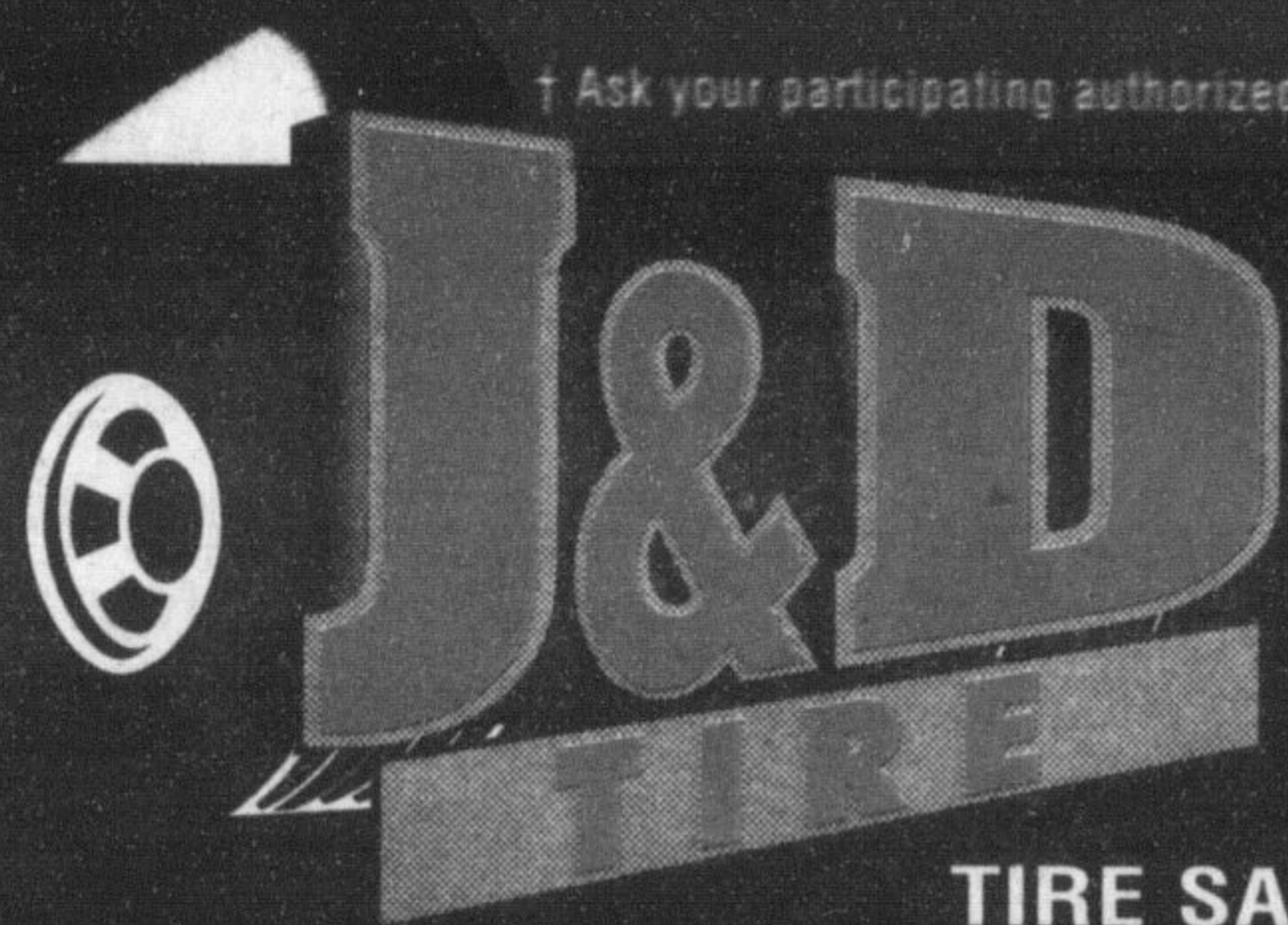

City of Guelph Water Supply Strategy Class Environmental Assessment Arkell Spring Grounds Municipal Wells

The City of Guelph has requested comment on a proposal to increase the wellfield capacity at their existing Arkell Spring Grounds by 6.4 m³/min to 20 m³/min (approximately 1,400 gallons per minute (gpm) to 4,400 gpm).

The Planning and Public Works Department of the Regional Municipality of Halton is inviting staff from the City of Guelph to attend a Public Information Centre specifically for Halton residents in the vicinity of the Arkell Spring Grounds to identify the potential impacts that increased water taking at the Municipal Wells may have on the private well supplies servicing Halton residents in North Milton.

The Region invites you to attend the Public Information Centre to learn about the Class Environmental Assessment and your opportunity to comment under the Ministry of Environment Permit to Take Water Process.
