
Lynne Crellin and Sarah Thornley of A Capella Showcase perform during a dress rehearsal in preparation the group's competition Halifax next week. Photo by

The Milton Choristers, one of the oldest performing community choirs in Ontario, is set to begin its 35th concert season this month.


