#### Internal Audit of Infection Control Practices at HHS

Halton Healthcare has initiated a complete audit of all its infection control practices throughout the various clinical, diagnostic and processing areas. This audit is being conducted by the Hospital's infection control specialists to enhance our infection prevention, control and sterilization processes. This audit will be submitted to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) by January 9th, 2004.

The Hospital has already reviewed the equipment used for the particular trans-rectal prostate biopsy procedure identified as problematic at Sunnybrook and Women's College Health Sciences Centre in Toronto.

"We are confident that the sterilization and disinfection methods used for this specific procedure meet both the current Health Canada infection control guidelines and the guidelines issued by the manufacturer," says John Oliver, HHS President and CEO.

Over the coming weeks, the Hospital will continue its audit of all of its infection control practices and will keep our patients and the public informed of any developments related to the cleaning, disinfecting & sterilization process. The Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) has approved the Town of Milton for an increase in designation of seven Family Physicians through the Underserviced Area Program (UAP). The Town has been identified as requiring 30 Family Physicians, and Milton currently has 25.
