



'Mini' nets two for win

Darren 'Mini' Haydar delivered his first multi-goal game of the season to give his American Hockey League (AHL) Milwaukee Admirals a 2-0 decision over Chicago Wednesday night.

Milton's NHL hopeful — who's been struggling to gain ice time and put up points this year — scored on a first-period deflection and again on a third-period powerplay rebound to fuel the win.

The goals were his fourth and fifth of the season, his second in the AHL.

Haydar's Admirals improved to 12-5-3-2 with the shutout victory and climbed into a tie for second place in the AHL's Western Division.

Milwaukee played host to San Antonio last night and continues its home stand tomorrow evening against Grand Rapids.
