









Dennis Hull is a 14-year veteran of the NHL, Dennis played 13 seasons with the Chicago Blackhawks before completing his career in Detroit. In all, Dennis played in over 1000 games and was a key member of the Canadian victory at the 1972 Summit Series. Dennis Hull's personality and comedic style have made him a well-known and much sought after entertainer and key note speaker.

Wendel Clark electrified fans and kept the competition honest during his spectacular career in the National Hockey League. The most popular winger in Maple Leaf History, this former Toronto Maple Leaf captain played 18 National Hockey League seasons before his retirement in 2000.

Mike O'Shea is #50 Linebacker with the Toronto Argonauts, Mike is playing in his 7th as a Toronto Argonaut and in his 11th year with the CFL

Marnie McBean is one of Canada's most accomplished Olympic athletes, Marnie is one of only two Canadians ever to have won three Gold medals in the summer Olympics

Luc Ouellette is one of the most successful harness drivers in history and has decided to make the Woodbine-Mohawk circuit his permanent base of operations. He has won 6,635 races and more than \$86-million in Canadian and American money in his career.
