# Search on for fleeing vehicle

Police have launched an investigation after a car failed to stop for a police check and eventually caused a collision.

Just after 1 p.m. March 3, a police officer was conducting radar checks on Guelph Line, south of No. 15 Sideroad, when a car sped away without stopping.

The vehicle began travelling south in the northbound lanes of No. 10 Sideroad, causing a northbound vehicle to drive into a ditch to avoid being hit. The suspect vehicle was last seen entering Hwy. 401.

Police are looking for a blue, four-door Pontiac Sunbird that has clear plastic covering part of its right rear window.

### Impaired driving, drug charges

Police charged a motorist with impaired driving and drug possession after a vehicle was seen driving erratically.

Just after midnight February 27, a Halton Regional Police officer stopped a car travelling eastbound on Main Street near James Snow Parkway and conducted an investigation in which a small quantity of marijuana was found.

A 54-year-old Brampton woman was charged with impaired driving, refusing a breath sample and possessing a narcotic.

### Home broken into

A Sixth Line home was broken into last Friday.

Sometime between 10:30 a.m. and 3:10 p.m., unknown suspects entered the home using a crow bar to force open a basement window. They stole a stereo, a DVD player, DVDs and a home theatre receiver.

### Vehicle stolen

A car was stolen from a Willow Avenue driveway last week.

Unknown suspects stole the 1994 Oldsmobile sometime between 5 p.m. March 3 and 7:30 a.m. March 4.

Police are investigating.

### Generator stolen

A generator was stolen from a Bastedo Court home last week.

The yellow and black lacquer generator was delivered to the homeowner's driveway and was stolen sometime between 5 p.m. March 2 and 8:30 a.m. March 3.

The value of the generator is estimated at \$2,300.

### School broken into

A stereo was stolen from W.I. Dick Public School last week.

Sometime between March 3 and last Friday, unknown suspects smashed the glass of a rear door to get inside.

The estimated value of the stereo was \$200. Damage to the door is valued at \$300.

### Bikes stolen

Two bikes were recently stolen from a Main Street East apartment building.

The theft was reported to police March 3. Unknown suspects broke into a storage unit to access the bikes sometime before that date.

The combined value of the stolen property is \$300.
