

Some school board meeting dates change

Residents who like to attend public school board meetings should take note that April's two gatherings will be held on dates different from the norm and, in one case, at an alternate site.

Instead of the usual schedule of meeting the first and third Wednesdays of the month, Halton District School Board trustees will hold meetings the second and fourth Wednesdays next month.

The committee meeting is set for Wednesday, Apr. 14. The start time for public proceedings remains the usual 8 p.m. but the venue has changed as well.

Instead of the public board education centre in Burlington, the Syl Apps youth centre in Oakville will be the meeting place.

Syl Apps is a closed-custody facility for young offenders. Trustees will be given a chance to tour the centre and be informed about the Halton public board's involvement in providing educational services to its residents.

Members of the public who want to attend the board meeting at Syl Apps must bring photo identification to enter and exit the building, which is located at 475 Iroquois Shore Rd. in Oakville.

The date change will allow trustees to attend the Halton Music Showcase on April 7 at Hamilton Place. The showcase features students across Halton.

The date for the regular meeting of the board in April will be Wednesday, Apr. 28. The venue remains the board office in Burlington, beside M.M. Robinson High School, at Upper Middle Road and Guelph Line.

The date change for the meeting will allow trustees to attend the Halton Skills Competition at Georgetown District High School April 21.

The presentation is being funded by Milton school councils and hosted by the Milton Parent Education Network.

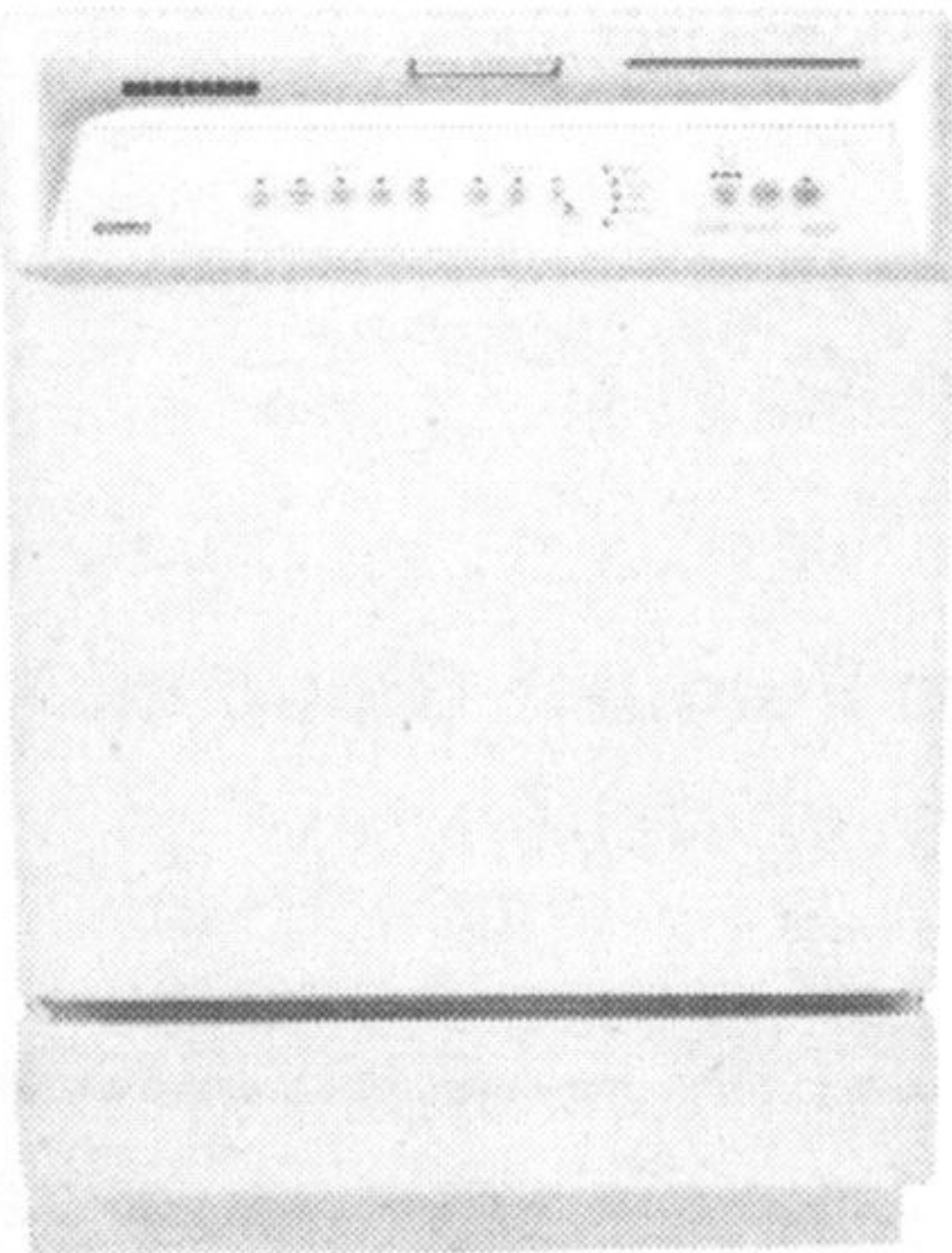
