## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE No. 2

### Steeles Avenue (Regional Road 8) Improvements Town of Halton Hills Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Regional Municipality of Halton has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment to consider a wide range of options to satisfy future travel demands on Steeles Avenue (Regional Road 8), from Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) easterly to Winston Churchill Boulevard (Regional Road 19), in the Town of Halton Hills. Potential changes to be studied include widening the road, new road alignments and improvements to driveways and intersections, among others.

This notice signals the second public meeting to solicit public comments on the proposed road improvement alternatives, and to present the evaluation criteria by which road improvement alternatives are assessed. This study will be conducted in compliance with Schedule C of the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (June 2000), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. 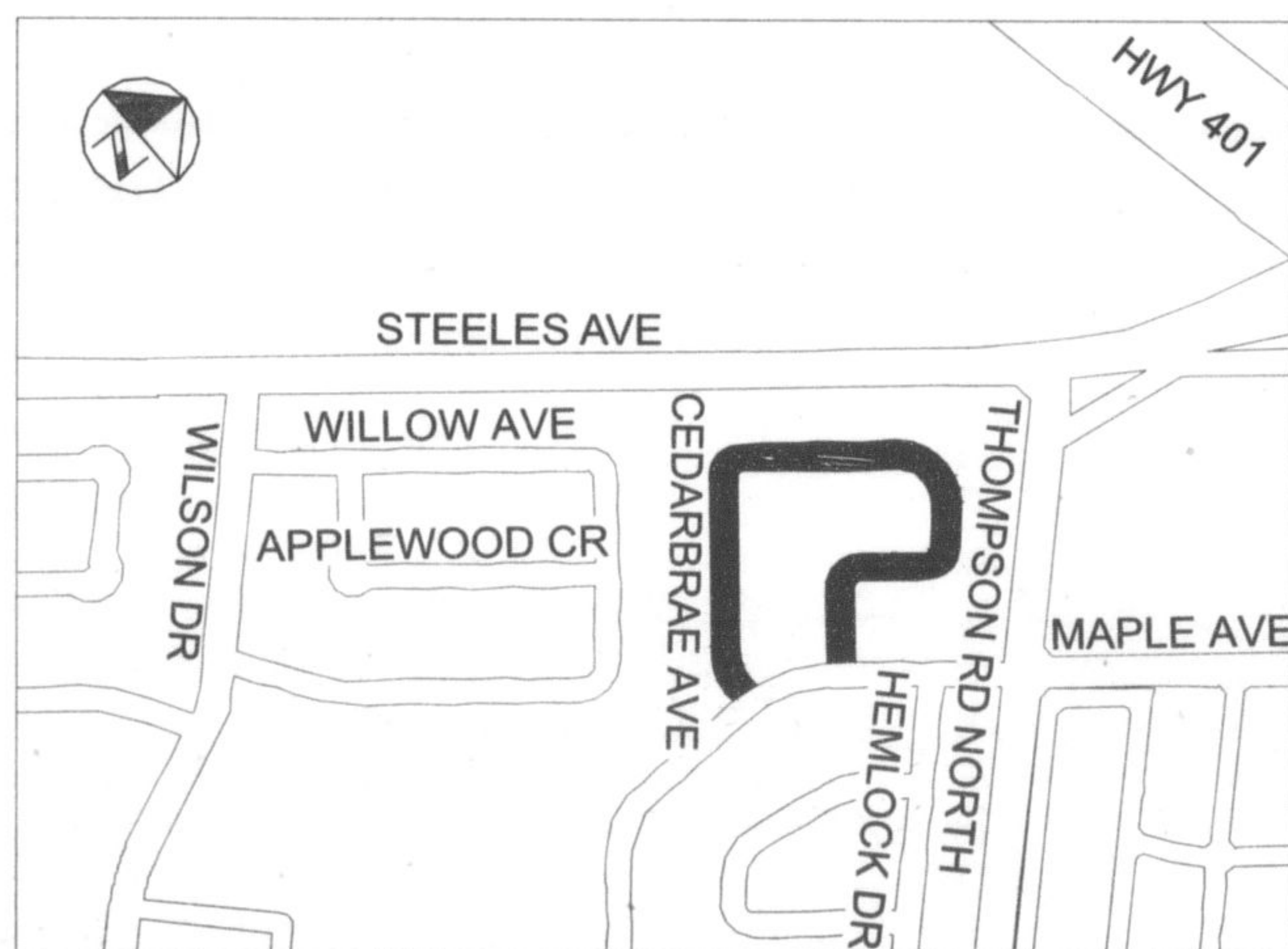

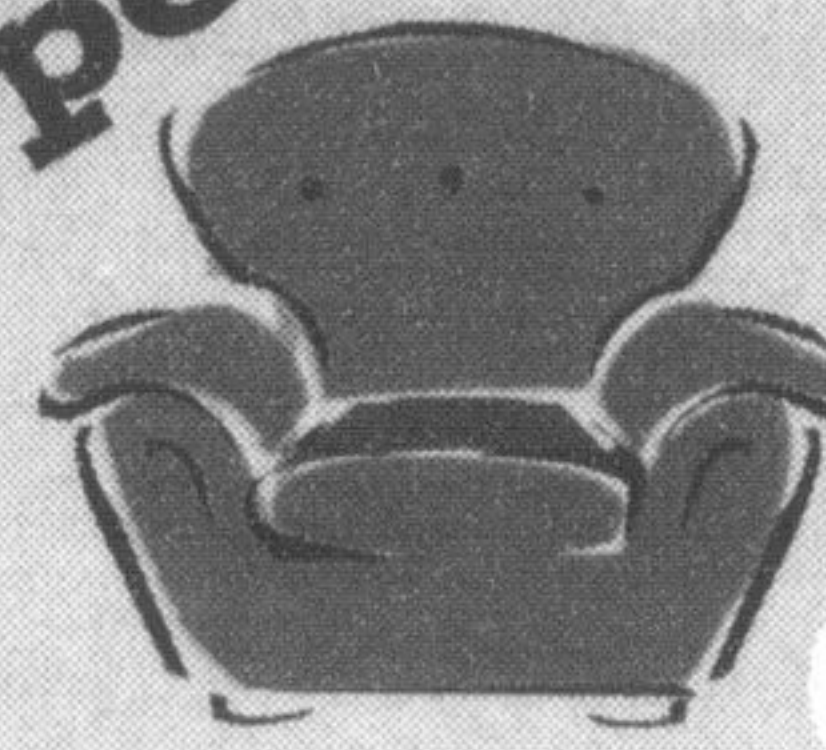
