

# Police searching for suspect in assault on T.O. man

Police are looking for a suspect after a 20-year-old Toronto man was punched last Friday.

The victim was walking westbound on Main Street, near Ontario Street, when he was approached by four white males on black BMX bikes.

The victim was grabbed and punched in the face before the group fled.

Fortunately, he didn't require medical attention, police said.

The man who did the punching is described as white, five-foot-11, between 19 and 23 years old with black hair and a thin muscular build. He was wearing a red sleeveless shirt and grey pants.

## Trailer stolen

A trailer parked at The Truck Stop on Trafalgar Road was stolen overnight Sunday.

The 1999 flatbed trailer was loaded with scaffolding when it was stolen by unknown suspects.

The trailer is valued at \$40,000.

## Mountain bike stolen

A mountain bike was stolen during a bicycle

race at Glen Eden on Kelso Road Saturday afternoon.

The bike's owner had left the bike at the top of one of the ski hills between 3:45 and 4:15 p.m. and when he returned, it was gone.

The bike, which is valued at \$8,000, was a black, 26-inch Giant DHTeam male downhill mountain bike.

## Air conditioners stolen

Three central air conditioning units were stolen from a construction site at Derry and Thompson roads.

Unknown suspects entered three unoccupied homes on Willmott Crescent, in the new Country Homes subdivision, where they found the air conditioning units.

The estimated value of the stolen property is \$5,700.

## Vehicles broken into

Two vehicles parked at Milton Chrysler on Ontario Street were broken into overnight last Friday.

Unknown suspects entered the vehicles by popping out the drivers' side windows. They then stole electronic equipment including DVD and CD players.

A home on Syer Drive was broken into Monday afternoon.

Sometime between 2:20 and 2:50 p.m., unknown suspects forced their way through the side door and stole an undisclosed quantity of cash.

## Gas cans stolen

Unknown suspects broke into the home's garage, where they found the gas, at about 3:30 a.m.

One can of gas was later found in a nearby Appleby Line ditch. Nothing else was taken.

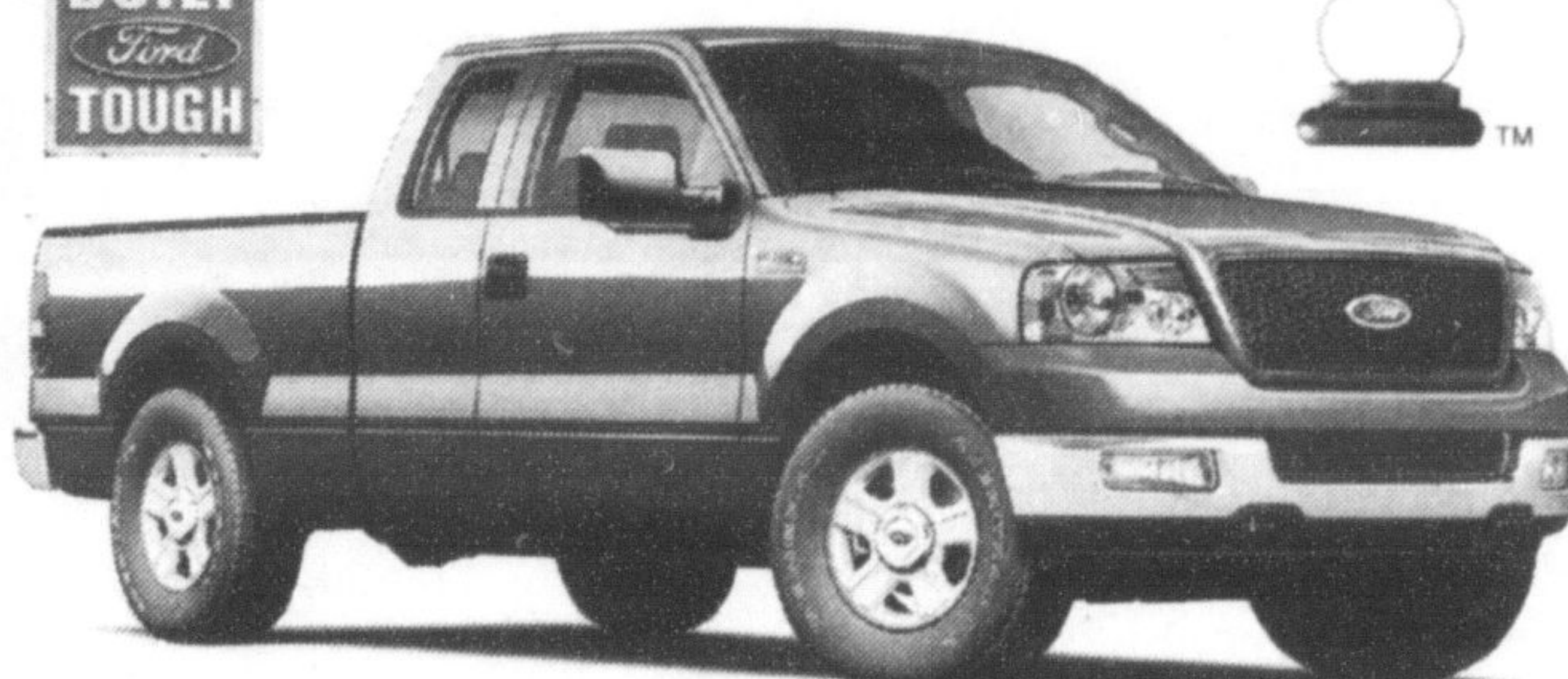
