There's even a chance to win a car courtesy of Milton Chrysler Dodge Jeep for putting a hole-in-one.

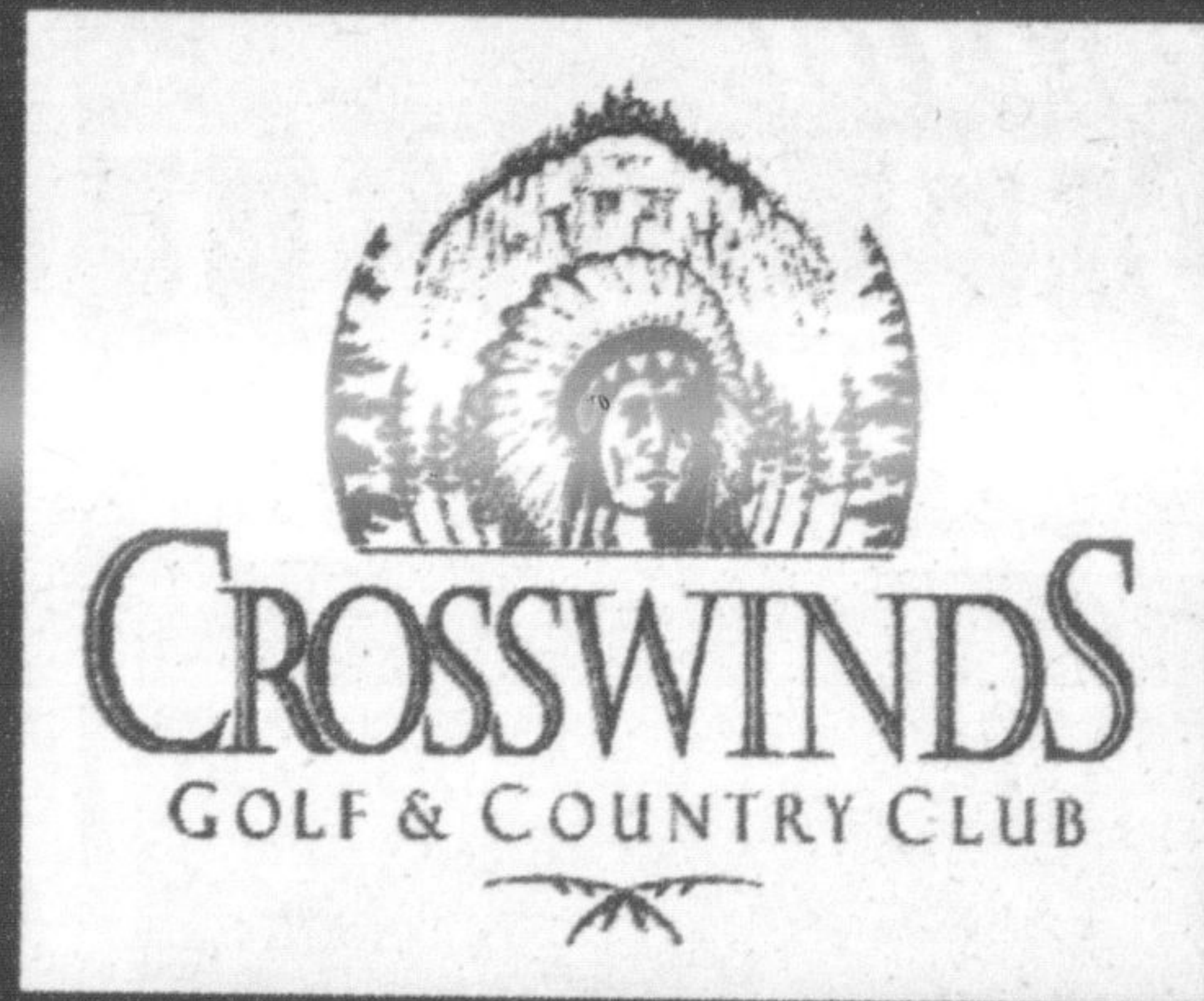
This year's official tournament sponsor is the Kinsmen Club of Milton.
