Lawyer charged with smuggling drugs into jail

An Oshawa lawyer has been charged with bringing drugs into Maplehurst Correctional Centre.

The afternoon of April 4, the accused was visiting an inmate at Maplehurst on a professional visit, police said.

Shortly after, a quantity of marijuana was seized by correctional officers who con-

tacted Halton Regional Police.

An investigation ensued.

A 69-year-old Oshawa man has been charged with possession for the purpose of trafficking.

He'll appear at Ontario Court of Justice in Burlington June 22.

Child pornography case back in court Wednesday

A Milton man accused of possessing and distributing child pornography in January will face the charges in court next week.

Kirk Scott Pierrepoint, 34, appeared at the Ontario Court of Justice in Burlington

Tuesday. His case was remanded to June 9 at the same courthouse.

The Oriole Court resident has also been charged with possession of a controlled substance.

Jail guard in court

A correctional officer accused of providing contraband to female inmates for sexual favours will appear in Burlington court June 15.

The date was set May 18 when the accused appeared at Ontario Court of Justice in Burlington.

Halton Regional Police charged the adult male employee of Milton's Vanier Institute for Women — part of Maplehurst Correctional Centre — with four counts of breach of trust and three counts of sexual assault in March.

His name is being withheld to protect the safety of the victims, police said.

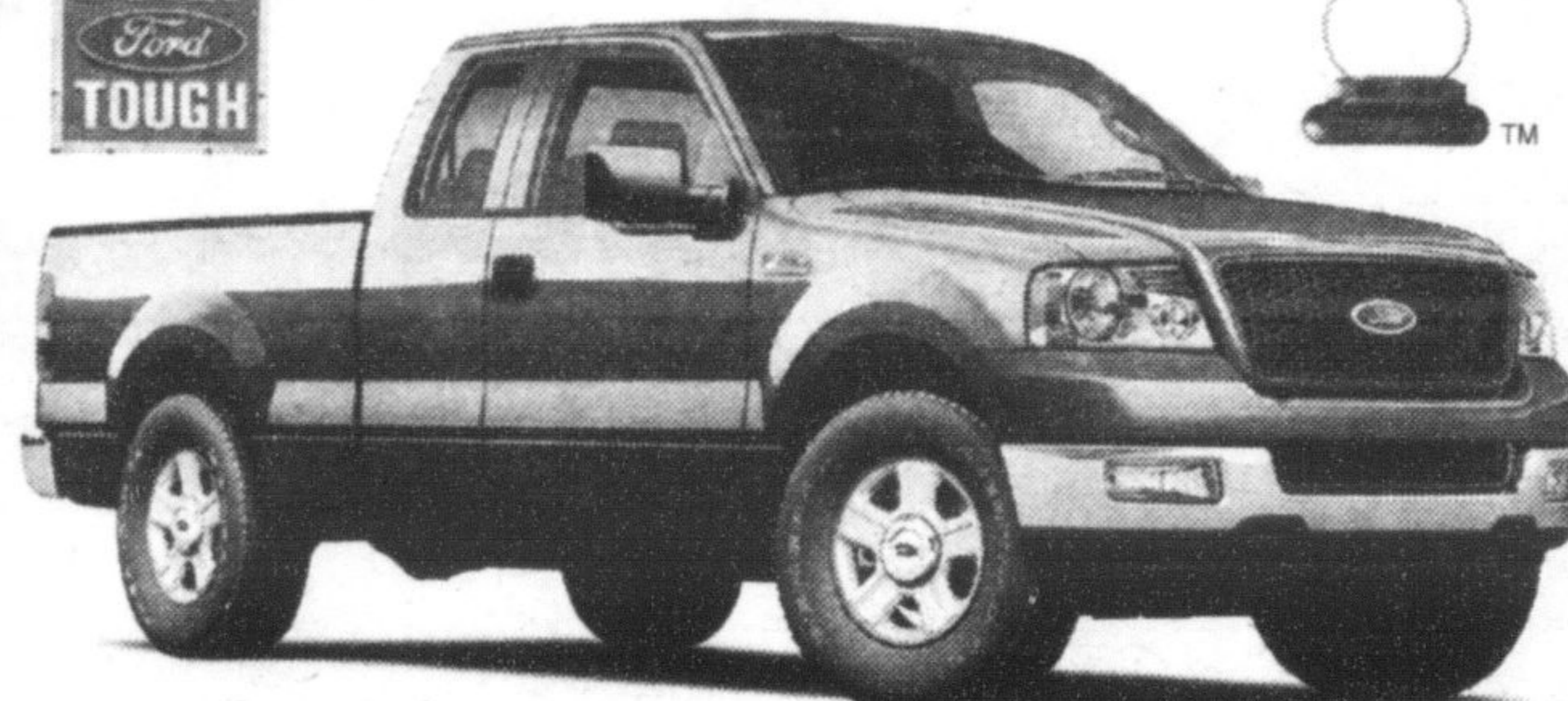
