woman he paid moms to let him have sex with their kids, some as young as five years old.

She became scared for her two kids, aged two and five at the time, the police report read.

After attempts to sever communication, the woman received more calls a few months later from Mr. Pierrepoint offering her money if he could have sex with her children.

In November and December of last year, Mr. Apel said the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) conducted an on-line undercover investigation of Mr. Pierrepoint.

He said Mr. Pierrepoint offered the undercover officer money to help him make child pornography, and sent the officer explicit images of young girls. Handcuffed and sporting a buzz cut, Mr. Pierrepoint sat in the prisoner's box with his head down, eyes on the floor while his lawyer, Mark Miller, told court his client didn't dispute the allegations.

But, Mr. Miller said, he wanted to make several clarifications.

"At the time Mr. Pierrepoint was making these offers, he was working at a variety of minimum wage jobs. He didn't have \$50, never mind \$50,000," he said, explaining the offers made were part of his fantasy world and weren't intended to be carried out.

He told court Mr. Pierrepoint didn't create any of the images found on his computer.

"He never engaged in sexual activity with a minor, and doesn't appear in any of the photos," Mr. Miller said. "That was something

of a fantasy role. The notion that he'd have \$50,000 to offer is non-sense."

Judge Baldwin denied Mr. Miller's request that Mr. Pierrepoint be released until his sentencing.

"That's not something I'm going to do — release a man in five minutes when he was bragging about having sex with children. This is very important stuff," she said.

In addition to the child pornography charges, Mr. Pierrepoint pleaded guilty to possessing a controlled substance commonly referred to as 'magic mushrooms'.

The case will return to the same court June 23.

Survey area covers 2,100 acres

Recently, a report was released that predicted a 4.7 per cent tax increase per year from now until 2021 to help offset costs associated with growth.

The draft report from C.N. Watson and Associates suggested the tax increase will stay under 5 per cent if developers pay a \$2,000 levy on each home and prepay some development charges.

So far, 3,400 building permits have been issued for the Bristol Survey Phase 1A lands, a required plateau that had to be reached before Phase 1B plans could go ahead. The entire Bristol Survey area covers 2,100 acres.

At the meeting Monday, Mr. McQueen said six of

the eight landowners involved in Phase 1B had signed the financial agreement. The two landowners that didn't sign were granted a two-week grace period to look over the storm water management requirements, a lengthy part of the agreement.

The Bristol Survey is one of three urban expansion phases planned for the town. Development, of this phase started about four years ago. The Sherwood Survey, which is in the draft plan stage, includes more than 13,000 housing units that could bring up to 40,000 new residents to Milton over the next 20 years.

The third phase, known as the Boyne Survey, covers lands south of town and is expected to occur approximately 15 years down the road.




