Man charged in disturbance at slots

A 43-year-old Acton man faces charges in connection with an incident at the Mohawk Slots last Friday.

Police were called at about 3 p.m. when a man was reported to be spitting and uttering obscenities. He was arrested without incident in the foray area and charged with causing a disturbance as well as breach of probation and breach of an undertaking.

He was held for a bail hearing.

Impaired charges laid

A 52-year-old Mississauga man faces impaired driving charges following an incident in rural Milton last Friday.

At about 10 p.m., police responded to a citizen's call and found a 1989 Chevrolet being driven westbound on the shoulder of Britannia Road.

A motorist was arrested and charged with impaired driving and having over the

Stolen vehicles recovered

Two transport trucks and trailers — valued at about \$130,000 apiece — were recovered at Trafalgar Road's Karas Equipment Ltd. Saturday.

The vehicles had been stolen from Peel Region seven days earlier and were found intact, with just some damage to one driver's side door.

Also at Karas Saturday, unknown culprits broke into the truck stop's restaurant and stole 86 packs of cigarettes and three liquor bottles — with a combined value of \$930.

The theft occurred at about 4:45 a.m.

Hefty rip off

A Trafalgar Road residence was targeted sometime between noon on June 23 and 9 p.m. June 24, when thieves removed a riding mower and siminized pressure washer from the side of the house and back yard respectively.

The stolen property — not locked up, but not visible from the street — is valued at \$3,300.

Child porn case continues

A Milton man who pleaded guilty to possession and distribution of child pornography last month will make another court appearance Tuesday.

Kirk Scott Pierrepoint, 34, appeared at the Ontario Court of Justice in Burlington Tuesday before Judge John Takash to set the date.

Mr. Pierrepoint's lawyer, Mark Miller, is

expected to have an order for psychiatric testing for the judge to sign at the next court appearance.

Mr. Pierrepoint, of Oriole Court, pleaded guilty to two child pornography charges along with the charge of possession of a controlled substance June 9.

His Tuesday court appearance will once again be held at the Burlington courthouse.

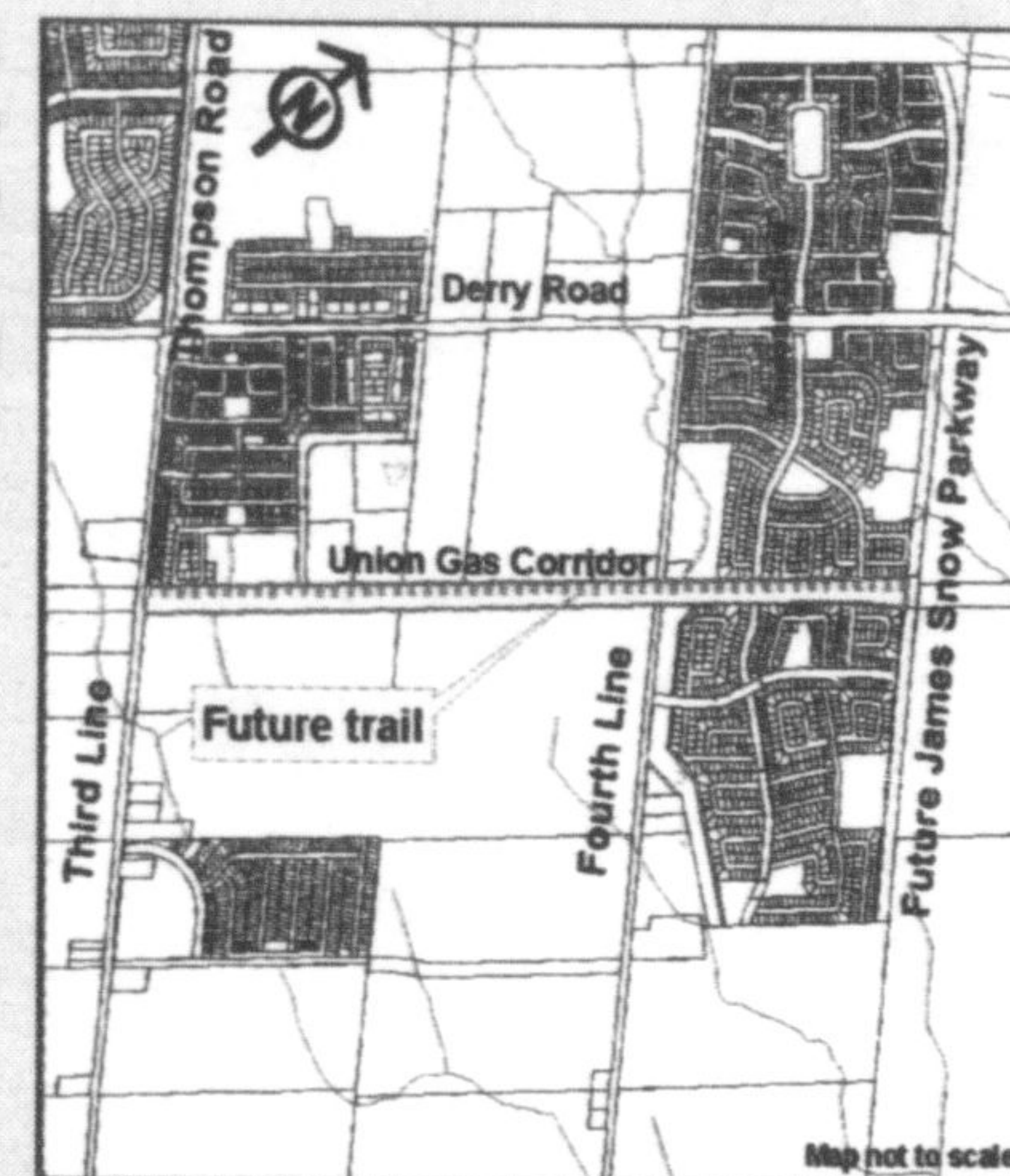
