

# Lawn mowers targetted in repair shop break-in

A large quantity of machinery was stolen overnight Monday from a repair shop on Steeles Avenue West.

Unknown suspects entered Drillco Foundation Company Ltd. sometime between 5 p.m. Monday and 6 a.m. Tuesday by forcing open the side garage door. A number of shop tools, lawn mowers and weed trimmers, valued at \$10,000, were taken.

## Drug store broken into

Police tracking dogs made unsuccessful attempts early Saturday morning to find suspects who broke into the Shoppers Drug Mart on Main Street.

smashing the front glass to gain entry, police said.

One hundred units of diabetic medication valued at about \$6,500 was stolen. Damage to the front window is estimated at \$300.

## Forklifts taken for ride

Damage was caused to a construction site after unknown suspects decided to take several forklifts for a ride last week.

Sometime between 10 p.m. July 13 and 2 a.m. July 14, police said several forklifts were started up and ridden in the area of Costigan Road and Miller Way.

The forklifts were driven into each other, and entered several houses under construction during the rampage.

About \$5,000 worth of damage was caused.

## Art stolen

Two art prints were stolen from a Steeles Avenue business July 7.

Unknown suspects entered Romac Inc. between 4:30 and 5:45 a.m. and removed the large prints from the lobby area.

The estimated value of the art is \$2,400.

## Jewelry swiped

A No. 5 Sideroad home was broken into Sunday.

Unknown suspects entered the home between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. through a second-storey window, using a ladder.

A quantity of jewelry valued at \$4,000 was taken.

## Suspects sought

The Mac's store on Bronte Street was broken into Friday morning.

Unknown suspects forced open the front door at 4:30 a.m., setting off the alarm, but once inside didn't take anything.

A security video tape showed two male suspects, but the tape's poor quality made it impossible to get a more detailed description, police said.

The damage to the front door is estimated at about \$500.

A TV valued at just \$50 was the only property stolen during the Saturday morning break-in of an Ontario Street repair store.

Unknown suspects broke into Brian's Auto Repairs between 2:30 and 7 a.m. by removing the window from the front door.

Police are investigating.
