

Police cruisers in rural areas to get defibrillators in the fall

Two defibrillator units will be installed in Halton Regional Police Service cars in the Nassagaweya area by September 1 with the goal of increasing the chances of saving lives in the community.

"The units are scheduled to be installed before September 1," confirmed Halton police Staff Sgt. Susan Delaney. "We will have a minimum of eight officers trained on the equipment and they are all very

interested and eager to begin."

The units cost \$5,000 each and are being funded by the Mikey Network, a project spearheaded by Heathwood Homes in honour of friend and colleague Michael Hart Salem — who died of a heart attack in 2002.

The Mikey Network's goal "is to raise funds to place public access defibrillators where they are needed most."

Approximately 6,500 people in Ontario suffer from cardiac arrest each year and it's critical to shock the heart within two to six

minutes of the attack.

The average response time for paramedics in Ontario is eight minutes although police are often first on the scene. The defibrillators will allow police officers to begin life-saving procedures if they're there before a paramedic team.

"This project will have a big impact on response time," said Staff Sgt. Delaney.

"Anything that can help sustain life until paramedics arrive is worth the cost. If these machines help save even one life, they've paid for themselves a hundred times over."




