Nearly 4 of every 10 trucks taken off road during blitz

Almost four out of every 10 trucks checked at a truck inspection held Wednesday in town had to be taken off the road.

"Twenty trucks were put out of service because they had mechanical defects rendering them unsafe on the road," said Jason Leeman, a transportation enforcement officer with the Ontario Ministry of

Transportation.

Despite this sounding rather scary, Mr. Leeman said the results of the inspection — held at Milton Memorial Arena on Thompson Road — were on par with what's usually found.

He stopped just short of saying the trucks were too dangerous to be on the road, instead saying they weren't fit to be in operation.

were pulled off the road, and one driver was prohibited from continuing due to an improper class of licence, Mr. Leeman said.

"It's a concern," he said of the results. "Our blitz produces enough results to justify us being out there for the day."
