

Man charged in grow house raid back in court Sept. 7

A Rockwood man facing drug charges in connection with the raid of a grow operation on the Milton/Acton border will return to court September 7.

Wesley Guy Whitford, 43, was charged last month by Halton Regional Police with produc-

tion of a controlled substance, possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking and theft of electricity under \$5,000.

He appeared at Ontario Court of Justice in Burlington last Tuesday and Wednesday when the next court date was set.

The grow operation was set up inside a barn on a Hwy. 7 property, between Fourth and Fifth lines. Halton Regional Police said 259 marijuana plants were seized June 9 in various stages of growth with a potential street value of \$259,000. Also seized was about \$2,000 in growing

equipment.

Police said Mr. Whitford rented the barn where the marijuana was seized and lived on the same street as the grow house.

Two Milton men are also facing charges in connection with the incident.

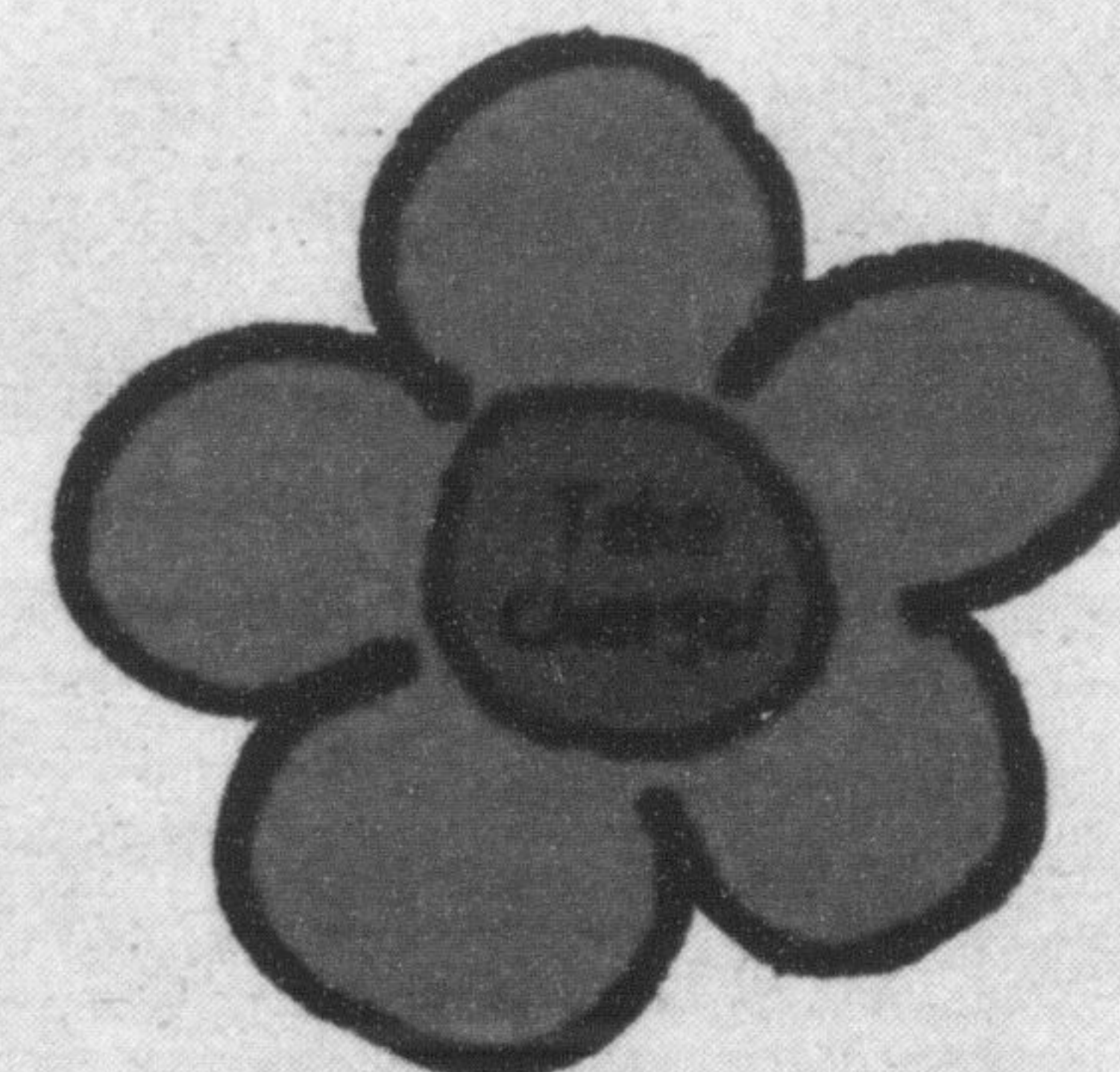
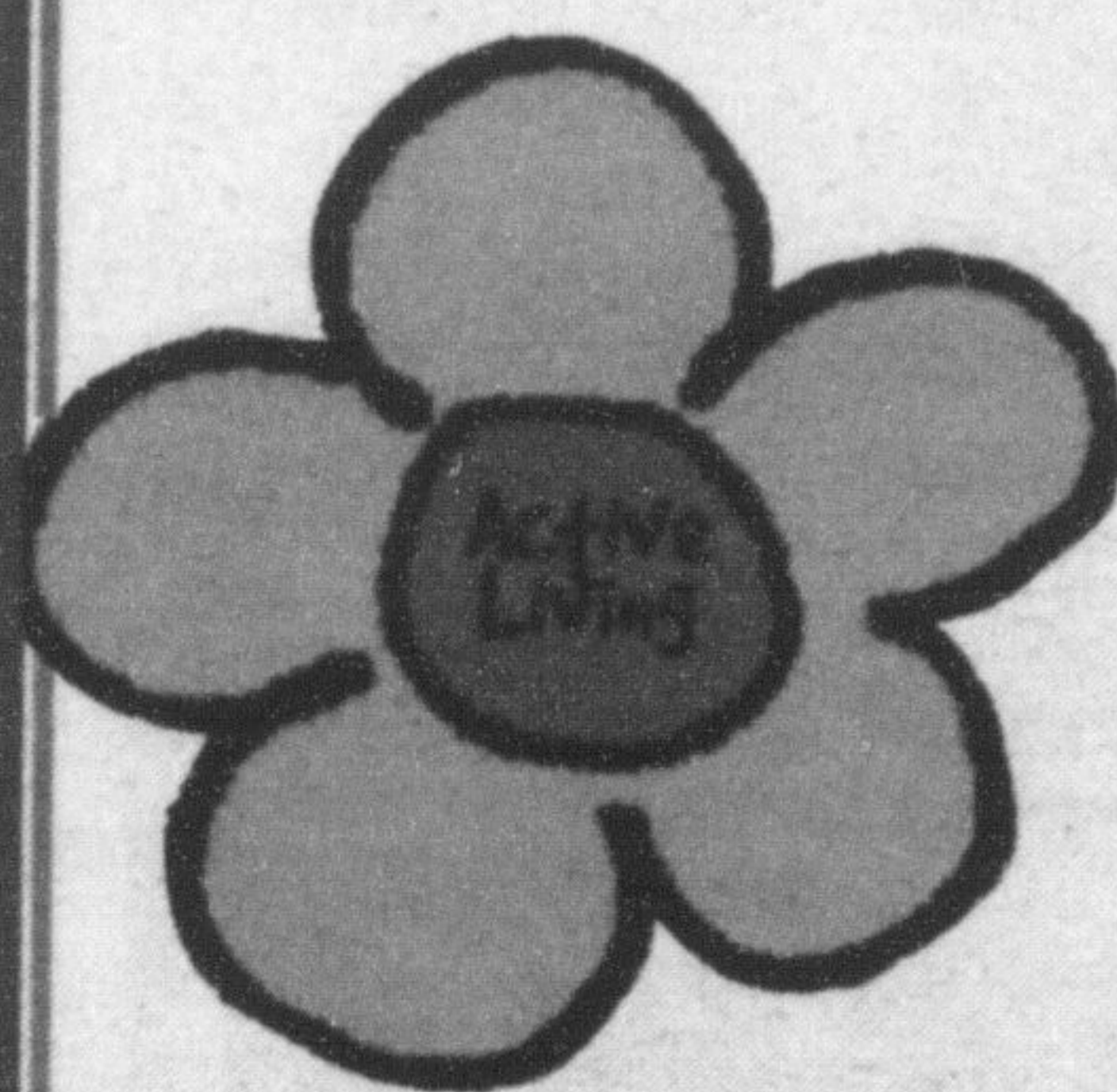
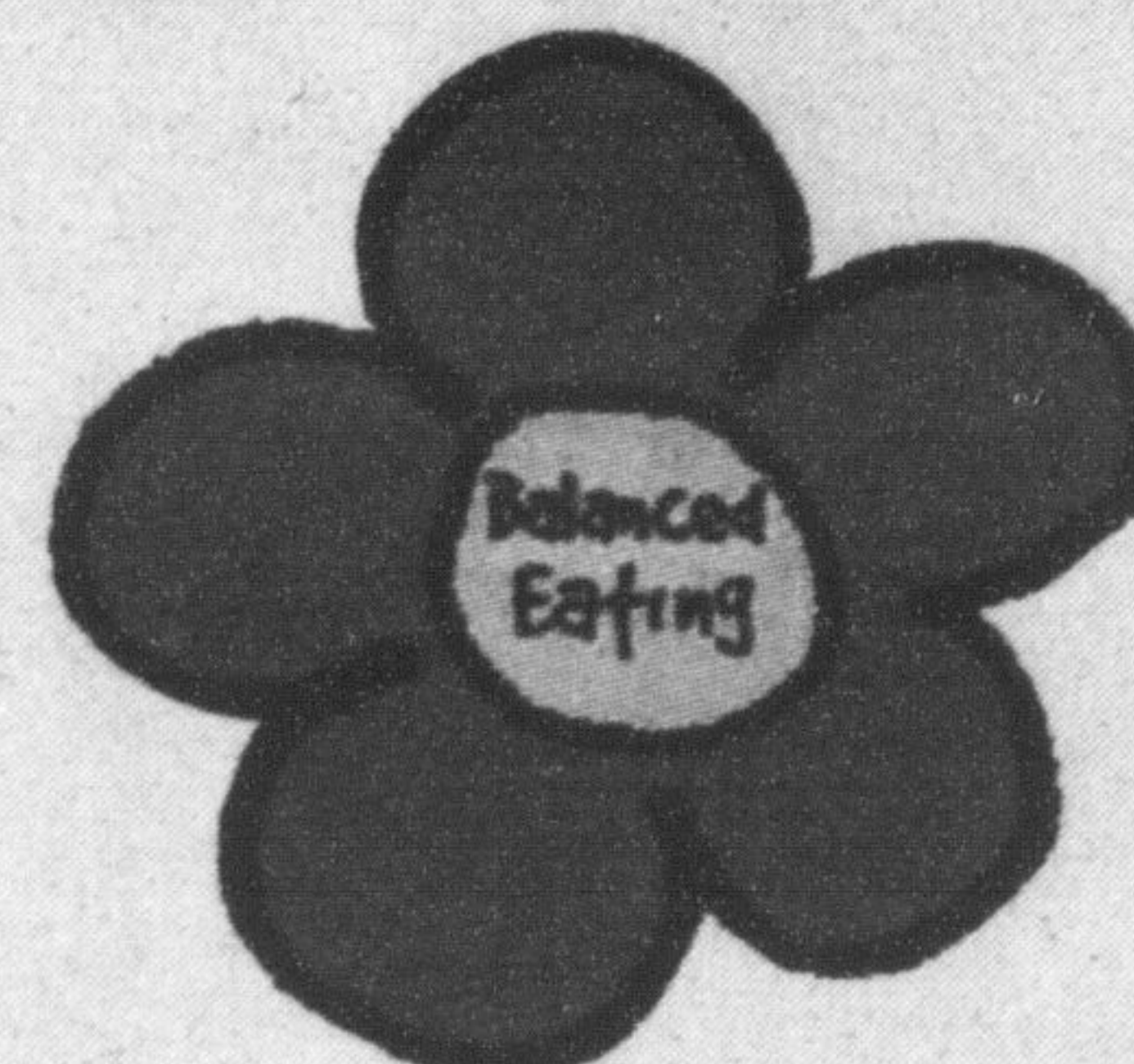
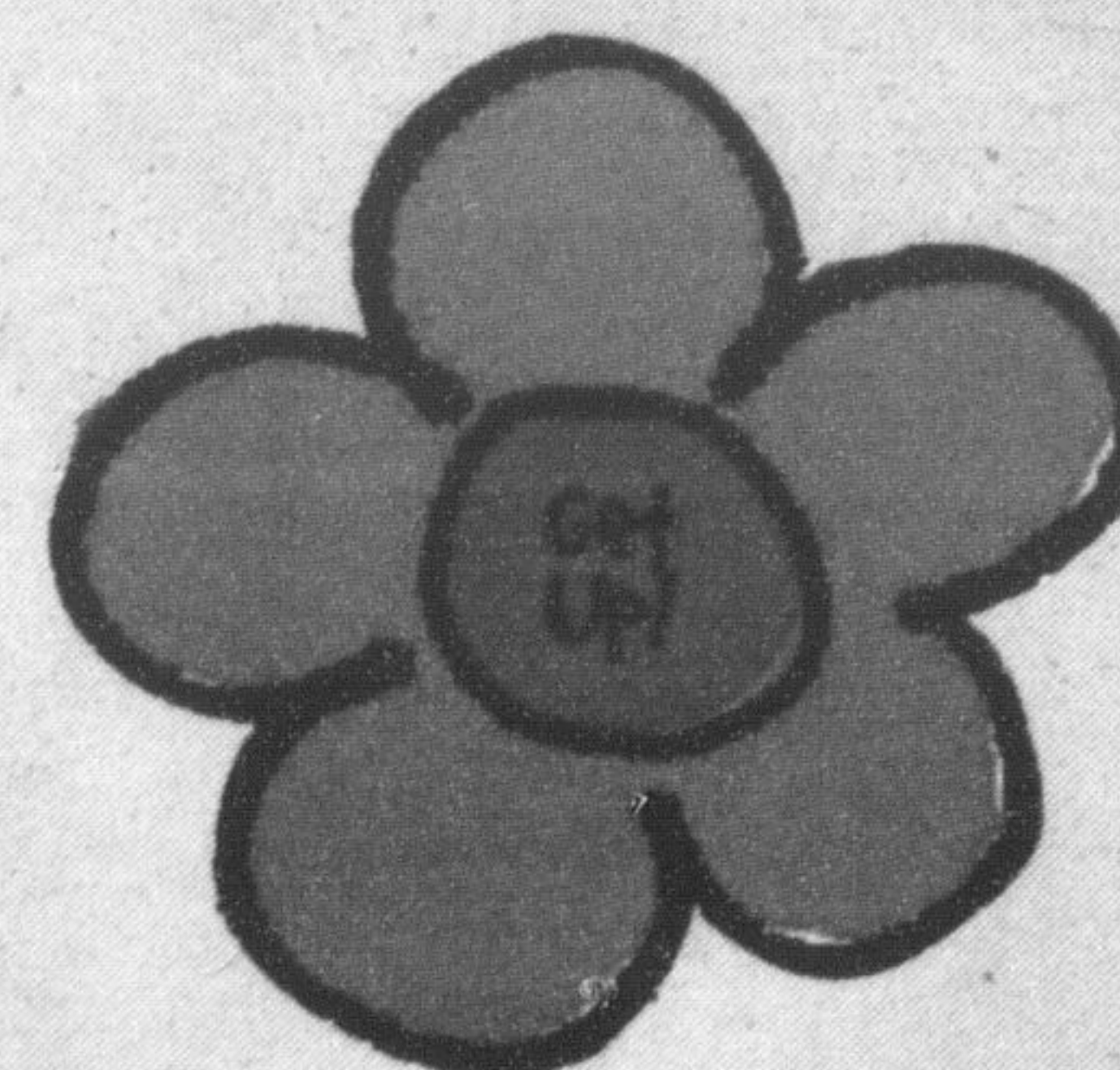
Go Girls! Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds
