the United Way of Milton.

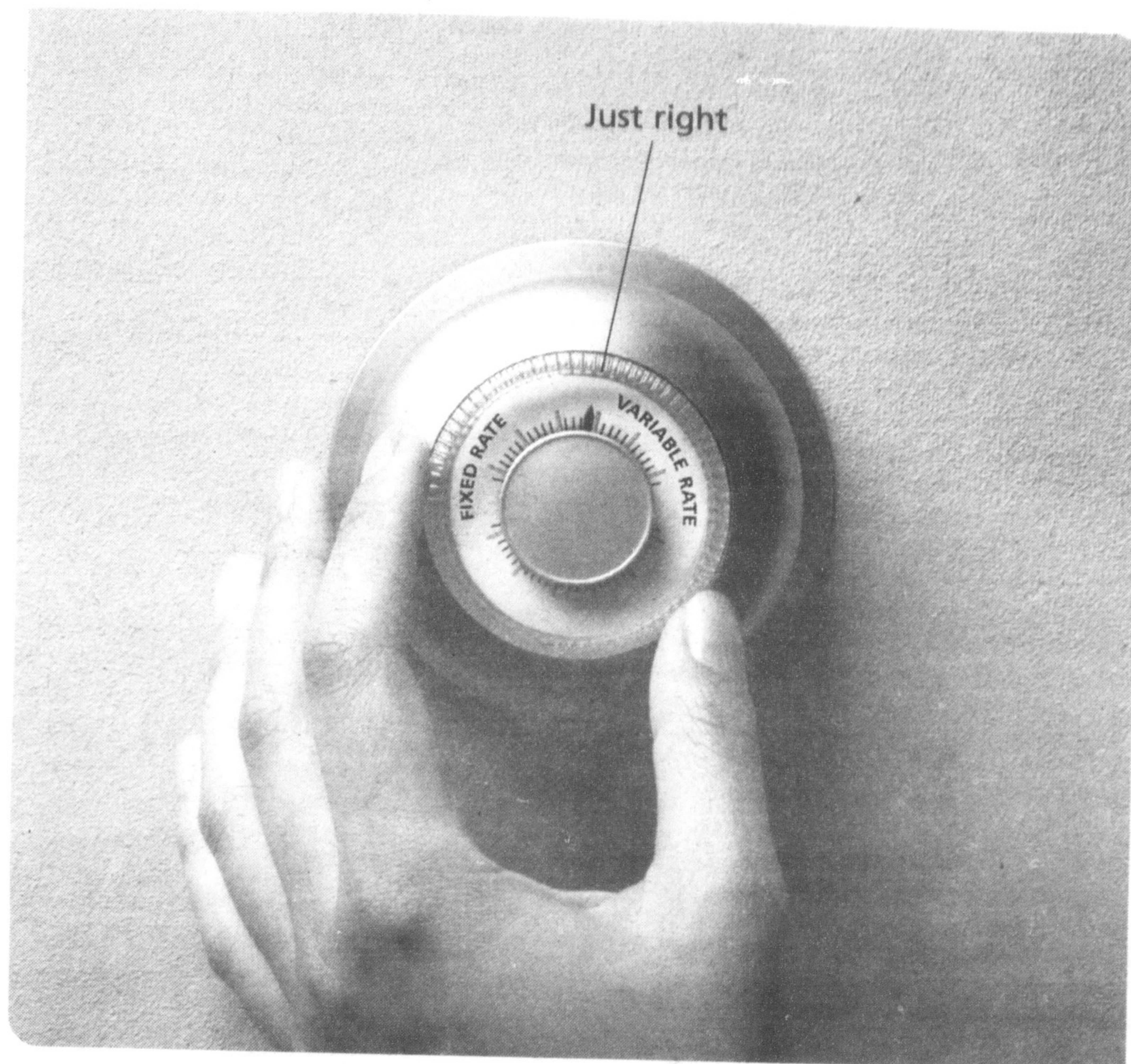
"Our most popular feature is our Corporate Foursome program, which includes golf, lunch, dinner and sponsorship recognition for \$1,000," Mr. Watson said.

Free Hepatitis vaccines

The Halton Region Health Department is offering free Hepatitis A and B vaccines for high-risk individuals.

Those that fall into the high-risk category are people with chronic liver disease, household and sexual contacts of a person with Hepatitis A or B, injection drug users and homosexual males.

The Hepatitis A vaccination program recently became available through funding the health department received from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.

A mass media campaign will start soon at Halton GO Transit stations in an effort to

increase awareness about the free vaccine program.

Individuals eligible for the vaccine through Halton's Hepatitis A and B program can obtain it through their doctor, other health care providers, or by attending one of the health department's community immunization clinics.
