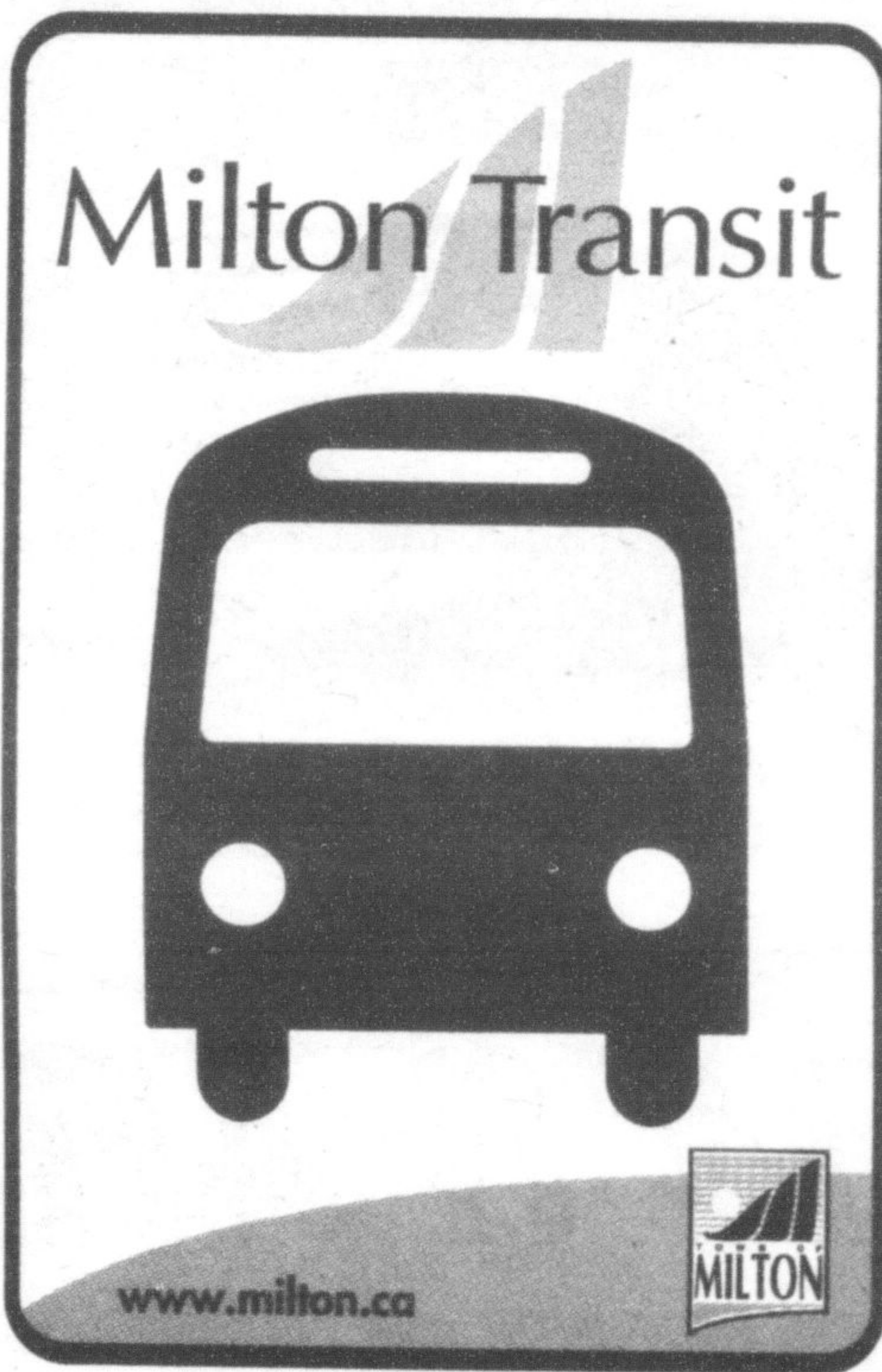

There are no changes to this service for riders with disabilities.

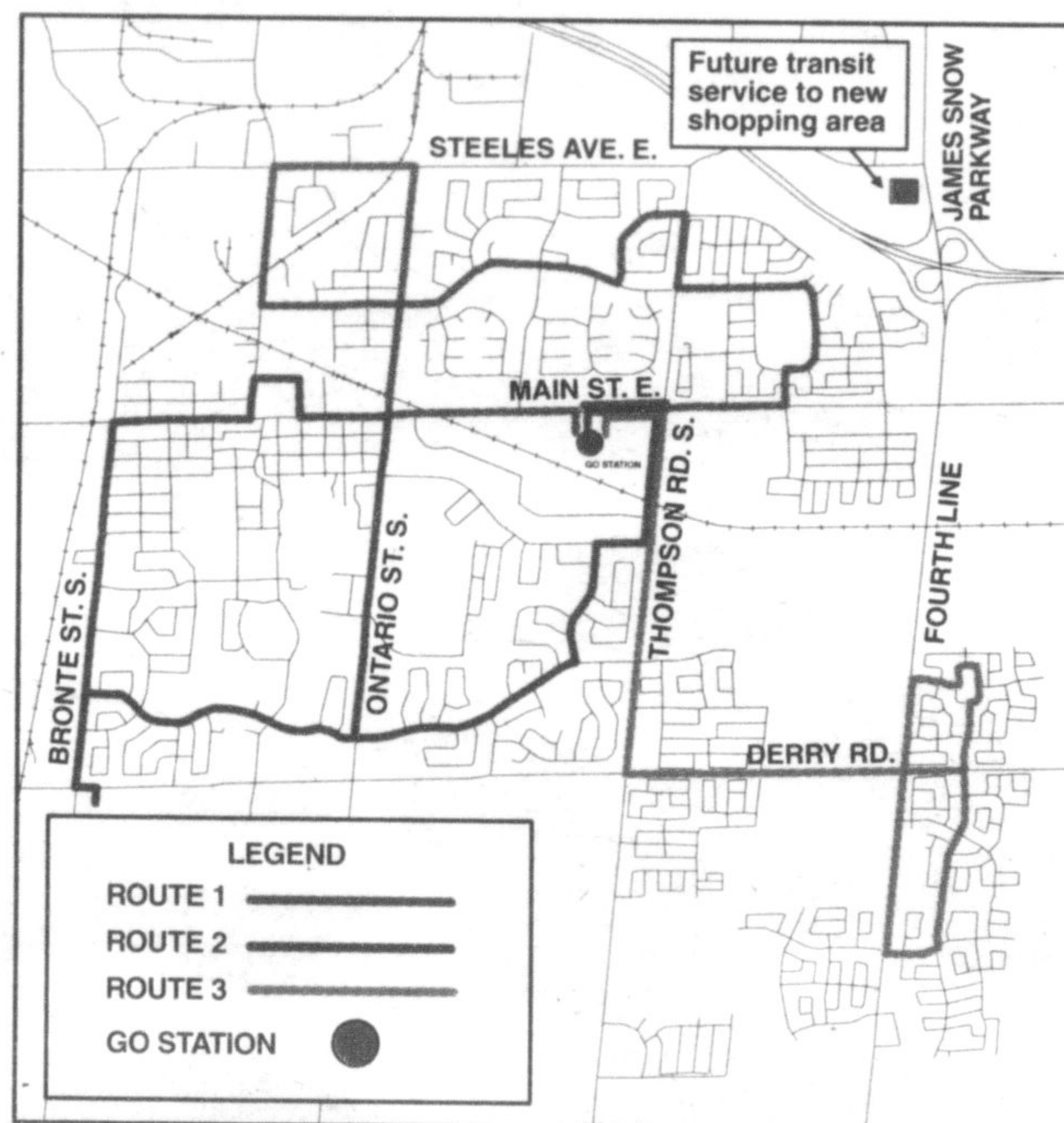
