

Defibrillator program comes to life in town

The Town and local firefighters are getting ready to bring the defibrillator program to life in Milton next month.

The initiative will bring defibrillators, electronic devices used to get a person's heart beating normally again, to the fire department and municipal facilities.

Firefighter Barry Kory said seven defibrillators will be put in the department's front-line vehicles, hopefully by the end of September.

"We're now providing something we


couldn't provide before. Basically, it's another tool for our tool kit," he said. "The boys are getting anxious to get them on the trucks."

The Town will have a total of nine defibrillators, with the first four being installed next month at Town Hall, Milton Leisure Centre, Rotary Park pool and Milton Public Library.

Town staff and firefighters have been training this month on how to properly use the new equipment, along with learning more about respiratory and heart systems.
