Until next Friday, the Milton Fall Fair is accepting applications for its 2004 Milton Fair Ambassador Competition.



Entry forms and rules can be picked up at the Milton Fair Grounds office Tuesday or Thursday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.


The final judging will be held September 24 at 6 p.m. at Exhibition Hall at the Milton Fair Grounds.


