The new roof came thanks to an \$84,000 grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation.

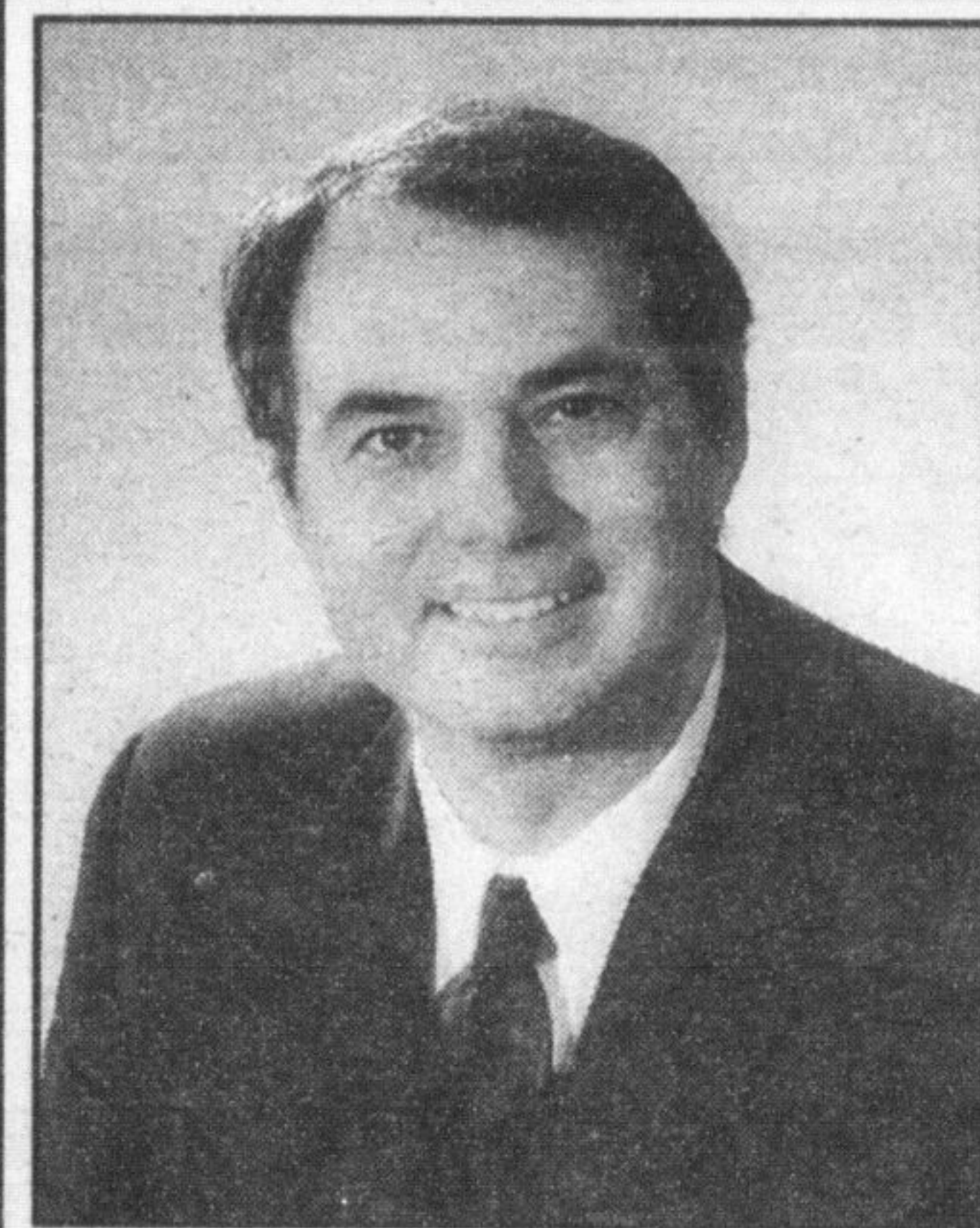
Mayor Gord Krantz and town councillors John Challinor and Wendy Schau will join a Trillium Foundation representative at 11:30 a.m. for the ceremony, along with members of the congregation and representatives of some of the community groups that use St. Paul's as a meeting place.

The Christian Education Centre was

built in 1962 and has served as a venue for hundreds of community and non-profit organizations since then.

Last year, more than 60 groups and 10,000 Miltonians passed through the doors of the church.

"The need is increasing for accessible, affordable meeting space for the wonderful community organizations that enhance the social fabric of our town," said Doug Walker, church council vice-chair. "St. Paul's has met that need and this was recognized by the Ontario Trillium Foundation in awarding us the grant to replace the roof."
