The CMHA's 1st Annual Fall Art and Essay Contest is asking interested people to submit art and essays as inspiration and motivation for others and to create awareness and a better understanding of mental illness. The art and essays will be judged and winners will be acknowledged. Prizes will be awarded.

Mental Illness Awareness Week in Canada is October 4-10.

There will be three age categories contestants can enter: youth, up to 18; adult, 19-55; and seniors, 55-plus.

In the art division, one of following can be submitted: a poster promoting Mental Illness Awareness Week; a bookmark with a favorite motivational quote or words of wisdom; a painting, drawing or sketch

As an alternative, a short story to a maximum of 500 words can be entered as it relates to your experience with mental illness, or an act of kindness you have received and as an expression of gratitude how you will pay it forward in the community if you have yet to do so. One family member can submit artwork and another can submit an essay.

The contest is also open to caregivers and health-care providers who serve and support the mental health community of Halton.

All entries must be submitted by September 15 to your local CMHA Halton office.
