

Stay green as leaves turn golden – insulate!



- Insulate your attic where 8 to 20 per cent of your home's energy is lost. In colder months, insulation keeps heated air from escaping outside. Use fiberglass batt insulation like PINK®
 Fiber Glass Insulation for Attics for best results.
- Insulate around pipes and ducts.
 Multipurpose insulation is perfect for the job, conveniently packaged in small quantities.
- Check your water heater. Water heating costs typically account for about 10 to 20 per cent of your total utility bill. An old water heater that is


warm to the touch is made more efficient by installing a special faced insulation blanket around the tank (and following precautions on its package).

Replace old windows, or add a second layer of glazing, to help minimize air leakage and reduce fuel costs by up to 15 per cent. To minimize drafts, wrap vapour retarder around strips of insulation and install with construction tape in large cracks (or seal cracks with a foam sealant) around windows.
