## Council meeting procedure may change

Milton council could soon be changing the way its meetings are run.

Town Clerk Troy McHarg brought forward an updated draft procedural bylaw and new council code of conduct to the administration and planning standing committee earlier this week that council could approve Monday night.

One of the most major changes, Mr. McHarg's report said, would be listing more items under the consent portion of the agenda, allowing council to approve a large block of documents all at once.

"The expanded use of the consent agenda will expedite the meeting process significantly and allow council/committee to focus the majority of its time on significant issues," the report said.

Councillors will be able to request that an item in the consent agenda be pulled out and put in the regular agenda for discussion or debate.

The code of conduct outlines general rules council members must follow on things like confidentiality and use of Town property.

"The council code of conduct would help to ensure that members of council share a common basis for acceptable conduct," Mr. McHarg's report said. "This will also serve as a useful reference guide, especially for new members of council."

The order of items on the agenda and its general appearance could also change slightly and the New Business section could be renamed Statements/Requests By Members.

Mr. McHarg said a new initiative through the draft bylaw is the incorporation of minute-taking standards.

He explained that this will help train staff and set clear rules as to what should and shouldn't go in the minutes.

If the bylaw is approved, any committees of the Town will be able to use it as a guide for their meetings.

### Growth faster than expected

Milton's population is growing faster than the Region may think, according to Town staff.

A report brought to the Town's administration and planning standing committee Monday night indicated that Milton's population is currently sitting at about 51,000 — 3,500 more people than what was expected for this year through the Region's Best Planning Estimates system.

"The statistics confirm that the town of Milton is, in fact, growing at a faster pace than identified through the Regional Municipality of Halton, with the Best Planning Estimates lagging approximately six months behind what has been determined to be actually taking place," Director of Planning and Development Mel Iovio's report said.

It went on to explain that in the Phase 1A urban expansion area, 6,177 building permits have been issued and as of September 7, 5,103 of those homes were occupied, resulting in a population increase.

Last year around this time, the Town's population was about 45,000.
