Within the next year, sweet corn crops will be added and, within the next two years, there will be more strawberries to enjoy.

"We are trying to expand our season a bit," said Ms Delvoie. "We are continuing everything that is already here and just adding on to it. We are now open year round, seven days a week. We have one full-time employee and, during the busy seasons, up to 15 parttime staff."

The spring and fall are particularly busy seasons with school tours, apple picking and pumpkin picking.

Long Lane Orchards offers school tours that entertain and educate students about a variety of subjects, not just apples. The spring tour is called 'The Puddleman Tour' and children have a chance to catch frogs, do a pond study, go for a wagon ride and even enjoy mud pies. The fall tour teaches children about how apples are grown and cider is made. Another favorite at this time of year is the Pumpkin Tour. Kids can learn all about this favoured gourd and how it grows as they explore the farm.

"We have repaired the wagon and made it safer," said Ms Delvoie. "The wagon rides are usually done on the weekends and is a favourite here. The new animal barn has ducks, chickens, bunnies and goats. There's a lot to see."

Apple picking started at the beginning of September for a few of the 22 varieties of apples. All the varieties will be available by the end of October. A few of the most popular ones are McIntosh, Spartan, Wealthy, Jonagold and Lobos. Everyone has a preference as each apple has its own unique flavour.

The annual Pumpkinfest is always a popular event at Long Lane Orchards. This year, it will be held on the Thanksgiving weekend and will include activities for the whole family such as a straw jump, a corn maze, storytelling, crafts, pick-your-own pumpkins and the always-available trout pond.

The baked goods at Long Lane Orchards are infamous throughout the community and have remained the same except for the addition of a few new prod-




Two-year-old Reilly Walton bites into a ripe apple while out picking with her parents at Long Lane Orchards.

ucts. Their best seller is, of course, apple pie. Customers return regularly to purchase the different varieties of pies, jams, syrups, doughnuts and cinnamon buns. From 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., the bake shop opens its doors every day for visitors to fill their sweet tooth.

But providing fun family activities is only part of Long Lane Orchard's mission. Giving back to the community is the other part. Long Lane Orchards takes pride in being a part of the community through its annual garage sale and its pumpkin sales.

"The proceeds from the garage sale are donated to Brookville Public School," said Ms Delvoie. "As well, a portion of our pumpkin sales are donated to North Halton Literacy. We have been in this community for four years and truly love it."
