



## Students, teachers proud of their new elementary school

These are snapshots from Thursday night's blessing and official dedication ceremony of Milton's newest Catholic elementary school, Guardian Angels.

Principal Sonia Bien spoke from her heart.

Bishop of Hamilton Diocese Anthony Tonnos gave an inspirational message. He spoke of the school, church and home all being important components in teaching children.

"I can see by the spirit that's evident here that Guardian Angels will be a great school," he said.
