

# Kelso offers chairlift rides to see colours

Milton residents are being invited to enjoy all the spectacular colours of fall amongst the Niagara Escarpment from a unique perspective this year.

This weekend and next, Kelso Conservation Area is offering chairlift rides up the brow of the escarpment to view the season's kaleidoscope of colour and breathe in fall's crisp, clean air.

Kelso is open both Saturdays and Sundays from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Kelso's Fall Colour admission includes park admission, taxes and a lift ticket. The tickets cost \$7 for adults and seniors, \$5 for children aged 5 to 14 and preschoolers are free.

Families can pack a lunch to enjoy in the great outdoors or purchase lunch from the park's barbecue stand.

Those who prefer a little more speed to their fall touring can strap their mountain bikes to the car before they head out, because Kelso has some of the best off-road trails in southern Ontario.

This year, it's offering unlimited chairlift rides to the top of the escarpment. Mountain bike trail passes cost \$6, and a combination trail pass and unlimited lift ticket costs \$12 for the entire day.

The first 50 costumed children at the door at 6:30 p.m. each evening will receive an extra special Halloween treat.

Admission to the event costs \$8 per person, and includes unlimited streetcar rides and trips through the haunted houses.
